Language: The working language will be in English

According to Eurostat, in 2020, 25.4% of young people aged 15-29 were at risk of poverty and/or social exclusion. In a Europe that promotes inclusion, equality and social cohesion, it is not justifiable that there are still young people who do not have access to effective development opportunities, namely beyond the formal context. Artistic and cultural practices have the power to: Provide development; Foster a sense of belonging; Raise awareness and transform mentalities; Affirm identities; Enhance critical expressiveness and autonomy; Encourage participation and citizenship; Break social, cultural and economic barriers. However, accessibility to artistic and cultural practices is often limited and not all citizens can easily access these opportunities.





# Project objectives

### Main objective:

 Promote access to artistic and cultural practices by youth workers, fostering their development and promoting young people's social inclusion.

### **Specific Objectives:**

- Promote the exchange of working practices and tools among youth workers, enabling them to be able to intervene with young people through non-formal and informal education and artistic and cultural methods;
- Promote practical experimentation with non-formal, informal, artistic and cultural methods by young people, so that they can explore their potential, tastes and talents and be motivated to active participation;
- To raise awareness in the youth sector and society in general of the importance of artistic and cultural practices for the personal, social and cultural development of young people, particularly those in situations of social vulnerability.

### Relevant priority:

 HORIZONTAL: Inclusion and diversity in all fields of education, training, youth and sport.

### Additional priorities:

- YOUTH: Promoting active citizenship, young people's sense of initiative and youth entrepreneurship including social entrepreneurship.
- YOUTH: Increasing quality, innovation and recognition of youth work. Both parts should guarantee the accomplishment of the priorities and take as their priorities during the duration of the project.





### Activities and methods

### **Regular Activities**

These activities relate to the activities of Management, Planning and Coordination, Monitoring and Evaluation of the project. They take place over the 8 months and are reserved for:

- The internal management of the project;
- The planning of specific project activities;
- The implementation and prior preparation of activities.

Preparation Meetings (online)

Preparatory meetings serve to create a climate of trust between partners and to deal with all practical and logistical issues (travel, accommodation, food, etc.).

- a) Type of activity: Preparation activity for participants and practical and logistical issues.
- b) Location: All countries participating in the project.
- c) Dates: Between December 2024 and March 2025.
- d) Working methods: EF, EI, and ENF.
- e) Countries involved: All countries participating in the project.

### Sharing Good Practices (TJ)

Activity for sharing, debating, and reflecting on innovative work methods and practices. Practical exploration of them, through artistic and cultural practices.

- a) Type of activity: Mobility of Youth Workers.
- b) Place: Paços de Brandão, Portugal.
- c) Dates: 20th 31st March 2025.
- d) Working methods: EF, EI, and ENF.
- e) Countries involved: All countries participating in the project.





### **Local Sessions**

The activity starts locally, with the YWs (Youth Workers) trained in Activity 1 exploring new practices and working methods with their local youth (i.e., implementing the work plan co-created by the YWs).

- a) Type of activity: Local experimental learning.
- b) Place: Paços de Brandão, Portugal.
- c) Dates: January 2025.
- d) Working methods: EF, EI, and ENF.
- e) Countries involved: All countries participating in the project.

### **Experimental Learning (Youth)**

This activity concerns work with youth workers, following on from the previous activity, through a mobility activity, with the aim of putting youth workers through a multicultural experience, based on artistic and cultural practices.

- a) Type of activity: Youth mobility, using experimental learning.
- b) Place: Paços de Brandão, Portugal.
- c) Dates: 21st 30th March 2025.
- d) Working methods: EF, EI, and ENF.
- e) Countries involved: All countries participating in the project.

### **Dissemination Events**

Activity related to the dissemination of results achieved with mobility.

- a) Type of activity: Event to disseminate results.
- b) Location: All countries participating in the project.
- c) This activity will take place at different times, as there are two different mobilities.
- d) Countries involved: All countries participating in the project.

The place of most activities being run at the CiRAC Association.

There will also be the possibility of visiting Santa Maria da Feira, Espinho and/or the city of Porto.





# Profile of participants

Each partner should send 4 youth workers. Gender balance should be paid attention to. Two out of four should belong to the Fewer Opportunities (FO) quadrant

### **DIRECT TARGET GROUP: YOUTH WORKERS (YW)**

General Profile:

- a) Aged 18 or over;
- b) Experience working with young people, particularly those with fewer opportunities;
- c) Knowledgeable and/or interested in learning about the Erasmus+ Programme;
- d) Knowledgeable about European priorities;
- e) Interested in informal and non-formal education methodologies;
- f) Interested in the role of art and culture in promoting social inclusion, cohesion, and equal opportunities;
- g) Able to recognize the needs, objectives, and impacts of the project;
- h) Motivated to actively and critically participate;
- i) Recognize the importance of youth in Europe.

Additional Criteria for Participants with Fewer Opportunities:

- a) Facing at least one obstacle to participation;
- b) Little or no experience in international projects (new participants);
- c) Little or no knowledge of the Erasmus+ Programme;
- d) Limited experience with non-formal education methodologies.

#### INDIRECT TARGET GROUP

- Other TJs;
- Other organizations in the youth sector and arts and culture;
- Other young people;
- Schools and other bodies responsible for educating young people;
- Social agents (teachers, guardians, family members, friends, etc.);
- Agents with decision-making power;
- Society.





### Travel

Participants should contact their sending organization for travel arrangements! As a travel option, we suggest arriving by plane to Francisco Sá Carneiro Airport.

The castle at Santa Maria da Feira was built in the 10th century, before Portugal became a country. Situated on the Douro coastline, INATEL Santa Maria da Feira offers its visitors the restful tranquillity of direct contact with nature, making for an unforgettable stay.

In the vital core of what was once "Civitas Santae", now the lands of Santa Maria, next to a wooded hill where the castle reaches up to the sky, an important fair sprang up, which later gave rise to the settlement. INATEL Santa Maria da Feira has 80 totally equipped rooms.
