




About the youth exchange:

Adaptability and Problem-Solving: Participants will engage in exercises to enhance their ability to think critically and adjust to changing circumstances.

Self-Discipline and Responsibility: By practicing self-reflection and accountability, young leaders will strengthen their ability to stay focused and committed to their goals.
