








Alqueva, Portugal August 26 - 30, 2025

Project information

This transnational mobility of young people (YE) is part of the project approved under the accreditation of the Associação Sementes de Esperança at the level of the Erasmus Programme. The low values of young people's participation in democratic life reveal the need to invest in a project that promotes volunteering and activism among young Europeans as a vector for their inclusion and social and civic participation. The problem addressed is the lack of participation of young people in democratic life. The project responds to several needs: a better understanding of the individual and collective benefits of volunteering and activism, including the development of professionally useful skills and the reduction of social exclusion, in order to increase motivation and engagement; the development of values and essential skills for volunteering and activism to foster confidence in participation; the use of non-formal approaches to explore the specific ambitions of each young person and align them with local needs, ensuring mutual benefit; and greater knowledge about existing opportunities in the field of volunteering and activism across different geographical areas, to enhance access and involvement.

Objectives

General: Motivate young Europeans to do volunteering and activism, as a motor of inclusion and social and civic participation.

Specific:

- Provide young people with an opportunity for transnational non-formal learning and active participation;
- Raise awareness among young people of the benefits of volunteering and activism;
- Explore opportunities for volunteering and activism in different geographical areas;
- Develop a set of transversal and essential skills throughout the life of young people, promoting their ability to engage in volunteering and activism.



Hosting organization

The Associação Sementes de Esperança is located in Portel, in the Alentejo Region (Portugal). It has been in existence since 1997 and is an accredited entity for Erasmus+. Its work focuses mainly on the vocational training of workers and unemployed, the latter mostly with low qualifications and in a situation of social disadvantage. More recently, since 2023 inclusive, it began to carry out international mobilities of young people and youth workers, focusing on the promotion of social participation and volunteering of young people in rural areas and the training of technicians to work with them. During these two years, enough knowledge has been gathered in the nonformal education sector, not only at the level of youth work but also to train new youth workers, volunteers, facilitators and trainers who are starting to take the first steps in this field of Erasmus+ projects.





For participants

Each country will send 1 group leader (aged at least 18 years) and 5 participants, aged between 18 and 30 years, selected by each entity, promoter, and partner. All participants must have at least an intermediate level of English and be motivated to share practices, knowledge, and experiences.

Important: Participants under 18 years of age must have express written authorization from a parent or legal guardian to travel to Portugal and take part in the Youth Exchange. They must also be accompanied throughout the trip and the event by the group leader, who will be responsible for them.

This authorization must be signed by the parent or legal guardian and officially recognized by the competent authority in their country. It must include all the required information, as specified in the draft attached to this infopack.

Additionally, the parent or legal guardian must complete and sign a second declaration (recognition of the signature is not required for this one). The draft is also attached to this infopack:

Finally, two facilitators from the promoter, both aged 18 or over, will also participate. They have experience in non-formal education and a good command of the English language.


What to Bring

- ID card or passport
- Any necessary medications
- European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) free of charge
- Laptop for work activities (e-book production)
- Comfortable clothing and shoes (weather around 35°C), including swimsuit, beach towel, sunscreen, and hat for river trips
- Toiletries (only a face towel and a bath towel are provided), slippers, iron and personal care items
- Snacks (no alcohol allowed), traditional games/songs/dances/flags for cultural night
- A positive attitude and willingness to participate fully

Note: Alcohol consumption is not allowed during meals, activities, or inside the hostel.







Location

The project will take place in Alqueva, a town in the municipality of Portel, in Portugal, located approximately 190 km from Lisbon and about 20 km south of the county seat, Portel. Alqueva is a small locality with a declining and aging population. Its name comes from the word "alqueive", meaning "fallow land" or "desert land", which reflects the region's naturally dry and harsh soil conditions. These environmental challenges have long hindered the development of the area.

A turning point came a few decades ago with the construction of the Alqueva Dam, designed to irrigate the land and stimulate development in a region heavily reliant on agriculture. The dam was completed in 2002, and its name derives directly from this locality.


Food



Travel

The venue: How to get here (Alqueva)

Official day of arrival in Portugal: 25th August 2025

Participants may arrive up to two days earlier. However, the project will not cover any expenses incurred due to early arrival in Portugal, except for the cost of incoming flights.

On the official arrival day, only expenses for public transport from the place of arrival in Portugal to Évora will be reimbursed. From Évora to Alqueva, transport will be free, by bus provided by the Town Hall of Portel.

Welcome Dinner - August 25th, 2025

The welcome dinner will be held at 8:30 pm at the restaurant "O Artur" in Alqueva.

Departure - August 31st, 2025

The official departure will take place on August 31st at 7:15 am, from the Alqueva hostel, with free transport to Évora provided by the City Hall of Portel.

Important notes:

- Participants may book return flights up to two days later, but extra days are not covered by the project.
- Only the official departure day's transport will be provided free of charge.
- Those flying from Faro will depart from Portel by bus at 9:35 am, arriving at 1:05 pm.
- Others flying from Lisbon or Porto must reach those airports on their own using the recommended transport options.

Travel and Arrival Instructions


By 12th August 2025 (inclusive), all participants must submit the proposed travel details for both arrival and return flights — including dates, times, airports of arrival and departure, and ticket prices — via email to smtseperanca@gmail.com for validation.

⚠ Important: Do not purchase airline tickets before receiving confirmation. Flights must align with the project's official schedule: Arrival in Alqueva: 25th August 2025 - Departure: 31st August 2025

Participants will gather in Évora on 25th August at 6:45 PM.

Those flying into Porto or Lisbon must arrange transport to Évora, from where the organization will provide group transportation to Alqueva.





Arrivals

If You Arrive via Porto Airport

- 1. Metro to Campanhã Station
 - Take the metro from Porto Airport to Campanhã station (approx. 37 minutes).
 - Metro runs every 30 minutes.
 - Ticket can be bought at the station or from a machine.
- 2. Travel from Campanhã to Lisbon (Oriente Station):
- 3. Choose one of the following options:
 - Rede Expressos or Flixbus bus
 - CP Train (Campanhã → Lisboa Oriente)
- 4. Important: Buy your ticket online and choose only from the time slots provided in the info sheet.
- 5. From Lisbon (Oriente) to Évora:
 - Rede Expressos or Flixbus bus
 - CP Train from Oriente to Évora
 - Buy your ticket online and select the time indicated in the program
- 6. Meeting Point in Évora:
 - 6:45 pm, August 25th
 - Roundabout next to Évora bus station (intersection of Liceu Street and Avenida de S. Sebastião)
 - You'll be picked up by a free shuttle from the City Hall of Portel


If You Arrive via Lisbon Airport

- 1. Metro to Oriente Station:
 - Purchase the ticket at the airport and take the metro to Oriente Station.
- 2. From Oriente to Évora:
- 3. Choose one of the following:
 - Rede Expressos or Flixbus bus
 - CP Train (Lisboa Oriente → Évora)
 - Book your ticket online and select one of the listed times
- 4. Meeting Point in Évora:
 - o 6:45 pm, August 25th
 - At the roundabout next to the Évora bus station
 - A free shuttle will take you to Alqueva

If You Arrive via Faro Airport

- 1. Bus from the Airport to Faro Bus Terminal:
 - Bus stop is in front of the arrivals building
 - Trip takes around 20 minutes
 - o Only one Rede Expressos trip to Portel per day
- 2. Bus from Faro to Portel:
 - Take the Rede Expressos bus
 - Arrival in Portel is at 8:10 pm
 - A free bus from the City Hall of Portel will pick you up and bring you to Alqueva





Reimbursement

Travel Grants

The maximum amount reimbursable per participant takes into account the eligible expenses presented and paid by the participant.

Private transport, fuel, or expenses related to arriving in Portugal before August 25, 2025, or returning more than two days after leaving Alqueva will not be covered (excluding return flight costs and public transport to/from the airport).

Any expenses exceeding the amounts listed below must be covered by the participant and will not be reimbursed by the project.

Important rules

- Travel costs must be paid by participants in advance and will be reimbursed later.
- Do not book flights until your travel plan (dates, airports, prices) is approved via email.
- After the activity, send invoices or boarding passes (in your name) in a single email in PDF format to smtsesperanca@gmail.com, indicating your IBAN for reimbursement (must be in your name).
- Reimbursement will be made via bank transfer within 10 business days after receiving all documents.
- Expenses will not be reimbursed if receipts or required information are missing.
