The main objectives of our project “Smart AI, Smarter Youth” are focused on empowering youth workers and young people to effectively use artificial intelligence (AI) in their daily practices. We aim to achieve four concrete goals during the 18-month project period.

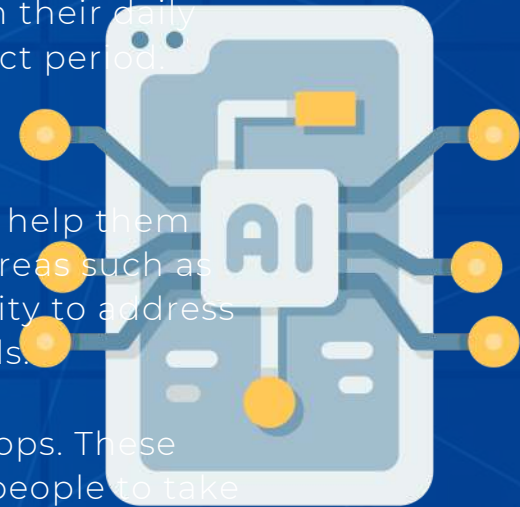
Our objectives :

To provide youth workers with practical experience in using AI tools. This will help them develop their capacity to implement AI solutions in youth work, especially in areas such as digital interaction. By teaching them how to apply AI, we will improve their ability to address challenges such as digital inclusion and innovative learning methods.

To encourage active participation in youth work through AI-focused workshops. These workshops will not only raise awareness about AI, but will also motivate young people to take an active role in solving local challenges such as digital exclusion or unemployment.

To create a strong network of youth workers and organizations in four countries: Slovakia, Portugal, Lithuania and Turkey. By encouraging collaboration, we aim to share AI tools, resources and methodologies that can improve youth workpractices. The network will enable continuous learning and sharing of best practices, providing long-term benefits for everyone involved.

To focus on non-formal education on AI technologies. By providing accessible and practical training for youth workers and participants, we will help them understand how AI can be used creatively in youth work. By focusing on participation, digital inclusion and problem solving, we will ensure that AI is a valuable tool to address youth challenges.

DESCRIPTION OF TRAINING

TRAINING OBJECTIVES

We will focus on organizing a 3-day training course for 16 youth workers from participating partner organizations. The goal is to equip them with practical skills in artificial intelligence (AI) and explore how these tools can be used to enhance youth participation, engagement, and innovation in youth work across Europe.

Participants

Total: 16 youth workers (aged 18+)

Countries: 4 participants each from Slovakia, Lithuania, Türkiye, and Portugal.

Participants will be selected based on their interest in AI and youth work.



- Introduce basic AI terms and concepts (machine learning, chatbots, algorithms, etc.) in simple and youth-friendly ways.
- Explore how AI is already being used in education, communication, and public services. Train youth workers to use AI tools in youth engagement and problem-solving. Develop scenarios where AI can help in project planning, digital content creation, or civic education. Promote collaboration and skill-sharing among participants from different countries. Build a network of youth workers trained in digital and AI skills.

FLIGHT OPTIONS

You can search for the flights to Bratislava, Vienna , Budapest or Prague. We recommend www.skyscanner.net

If you arrive to **Bratislava**, you can check connections to Trnava on www.cp.sk (bus/train, 30 - 60minutes, price around 5 eur).

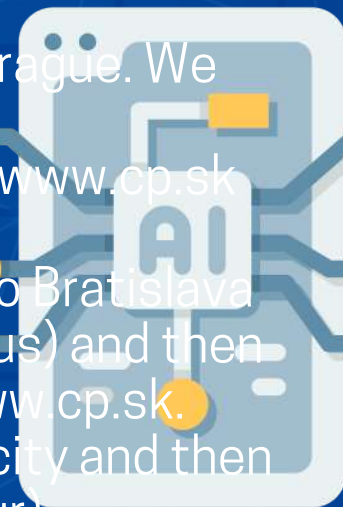
If you arrive to **Vienna** Schwechat airport, you will take a direct bus to Bratislava (duration 1 hour, price 5 eur, companies Regiojet, Slovaklines or Flixbus) and then from Bratislava to Trnava again you can check connections on www.cp.sk.

If you arrive to **Budapest** airport, you will take public transport in the city and then either a bus or a train to Bratislava (3 hours, price 15 - 20 eur).

From Bratislava to Trnava you can check connections on www.cp.sk.

If you arrive to **Prague** airport, you will take public transport in the city and then either a bus or a train to Bratislava (5 hours, price 20 eur +)

From Bratislava to Trnava you can check connections on www.cp.sk.

HOW TO GET TO TRNAVA?

Here are some useful tips how to get to Trnava.

From Vienna airport: The best connection from there is direct bus from the airport to Bratislava bus station (no need to get to Vienna centre). Please buy your ticket online with one of these companies: www.slovaklines.sk, www.regiojet.sk, www.global.flixbus.com.

If you go directly from Vienna airport to Bratislava - on security check you say "transit to Slovakia" and no documents are required. If you wanna stay in Vienna then you have to manage tests based on regulations in Austria on your own before your arrival (extra days or extra expenses are covered by you).

From Budapest to Bratislava: There are buses and trains from Budapest to Bratislava. You will easily find the connection with bus companies www.slovaklines.sk, www.regiojet.sk, www.global.flixbus.com, but I suggest trains <https://www.zssk.sk/en/>. It is up to you.

From Bratislava to Trnava: Getting from Bratislava to Trnava is easy by bus or train - the website to check connection is www.cp.sk (BUS - ticket to buy from bus driver, TRAIN - ticket to buy is in the window in the station or <https://www.zssk.sk/en/>).

ABOUT TRNAVA / SLOVAKIA

TRNAVA IS ONE OF THE OLDEST AND MOST IMPORTANT CITIES IN SLOVAKIA. IT IS A NATURAL CENTRE OF LOWER POVAŽIE, THE SEAT OF THE TRNAVA DISTRICT AND TRNAVA SELF-GOVERNING REGION. WITH A POPULATION OF 65 000 INHABITANTS IT IS THE SEVENTH BIGGEST CITY IN SLOVAKIA.

TRNAVA IS ONE OF THE OLDEST AND MOST BEAUTIFUL MEDIAEVAL TOWNS IN SLOVAKIA. IT WAS THE FIRST TOWN TO BE GRANTED THE PRIVILEGES OF A FREE ROYAL TOWN. IN THE MIDDLE AGES IT RANKED AMONG THE LARGEST GOTHIC TOWNS IN CENTRAL EUROPE.

TRNAVA COMES CALLED ALSO A "LITTLE ROME" BECAUSE OF THE CHARACTERISTIC COMPLEX OF UNIVERSITY BUILDINGS AND THE MANY PRESENT CHURCHES IN TOWN.
