You'll meet passionate people, discover unique places like Nikiszowiec and the Black Trout Adit, and get practical tools to better support young people – especially those from the NEET group.

Come with your team (5–8 people) and be part of something meaningful. Let's learn, share, and grow together. We can't wait to welcome you in Katowice!

The meeting will take place from 26 to 30 May 2025 and will focus on exchanging experiences, good practices, and methods of supporting young people – particularly those with fewer opportunities – in the context of social inclusion, non-formal education, and vocational development.

Venue:

- Katowice the capital of Upper Silesia, a modern city of culture and social transformation
- Wisła a picturesque mountain town where we will hold a one-day outdoor session at the OHP training centre

Highlights of the programme:

- 3 interactive workshops led by professionals from Poland and abroad
- Guided tours of cultural landmarks: Silesian Museum, Nikiszowiec historic district, Culture Zone
- Intercultural exchange evening national presentations and traditional food
- A full-day educational and integration visit to Wisła
- Reflective sessions and planning of future Erasmus+ cooperation

The youth exchange participants will travel using the organization's vehicle. The trip will begin on May 26th from Lithuania. You are expected to arrive on May 26th (in the evening) at the venue. The return trip will be organized in the same way. We expect you

to be back in Lithuania by May 30th in the second part of the day/night.

Participants will be driving the car all the way. You will need to pay for diesel and road taxes. However, these expenses will be reimbursed once you return home and present all original invoices.
