When: October 2th 2025 - March 19, 2026

Where: Youth Center “NOI” Via Roma 2, Moniga del Garda (BS), Italy

Spazio Europa Youth, based at the Youth Center in Moniga del Garda, is an initiative dedicated to the young people leaving in the beautiful area of Garda Lake. The project, promoted by the NGO Arte e Cultura Sociale, aims to promote youth engagement through social and cultural activities, offering practical workshops that help develop essential life and work skills.

Using non-formal education methods, Spazio Europa Youth provides engaging and educational experiences for young people aged 10 to 25. Additionally, it offers international mobility opportunities through European programs such as Erasmus+ and ESC, allowing young people to participate in enriching intercultural experiences.

The initiative strives to create an open and stimulating space where young people can engage, grow, and prepare to confidently face future challenges.

It also organizes intercultural language activities with adults, such as “language cafés,” which offer volunteers opportunities to integrate into the community and enrich cultural exchange.

Place for activities: Youth Center “NOI” located in Moniga del Garda in Province of Brescia, Lombardy region, Italy.

Number of volunteers and age: 3 (of age 18 - 30)

Objectives of the proposed experience:

- Enhance personal and professional skills, including project design, leadership, and intercultural communication.
- Support young people in acquiring skills useful for their personal and professional growth.
- Help young people learn languages through practical use.
- Encourage youth participation in community life.



- Promote youth engagement in transnational mobility projects.
- Discover intercultural richness through non-formal learning methods.
- Collaborate in events and initiatives dedicated to young people.
- Deepen knowledge of other European cultures.
- Explore more about Lake Garda, the province of Brescia, and Italy in general.
- Be encouraged to propose their own ideas and turn them into concrete projects benefiting the local community.
- Actively participate in managing social media and creating videos, photos, and posters.

YouthPass:

Voluntary work is based on the principles of non-formal education, all volunteers will get a YouthPass certificate after the project and describe knowledge what they have learned in project.

Accommodation:

The accommodation will be provided in a shared **ground-floor apartment** located in a beautiful residence surrounded by greenery, close to the center of Moniga and the beaches of Lake Garda. The apartment is composed of a fully equipped **kitchen**, a **living room**, **two bathrooms**, and **three bedrooms**, with each volunteer having their own private room. Additionally, the apartment features a **porch** and a **garden**, offering a comfortable and relaxing environment for the three selected volunteers.

The apartment will be fully equipped to ensure both comfort and functionality, with all necessary amenities provided. Expenses for electricity, water, and gas will be covered by the hosting organization. Volunteers are requested to use these utilities responsibly to contribute to sustainable living practices.

Board and transportation

We will provide an allowance for shopping and food and pocket money for personal expenses. The travel expenses will be refunded on the basis defined by the European Commission

Training during the activity

Pre-departure training for cross-border activities, guaranteed by participating organizations; - Training on arrival, guaranteed by national agency; - Intermediate evaluation guaranteed by national agency; Furthermore, the association provides all the learning support for the everyday activities based on self-managed methodologies, and also Italian language courses on OLS (online language support) given by the European Commission.

We are looking for 3 volunteers. The ideal volunteer should be a person that feels like to work with children, youngsters. We search for a person that fits in the values of the cultural center like tolerance, interculturality, participation and teamwork.
