





1. SHORT DESCRIPTION OF THE TRAINING

Our training for youth workers and leaders is dedicated to the development and strengthening of visual - spatial or imaginative-creative intelligence with the help of 5 techniques and methods from art (drawing, painting, collage, architecture and sculpture). The aim is to be able to use these methods in your daily work with young people.

The human mind is made up of different intelligences. According to H. Gardner, these are linguistic, mathematical-logical, visual-spatial, musical, interpersonal, internal personal, naturalistic and existential centre. With the project, we want to raise awareness of multi-intelligence and put the young person at the forefront, adapt methods and ways of working to their needs, strengthen their weaker intelligences and support the development of their strong intelligences.






1. FOOD AND ACCOMMODATION

2. TRANSPORT


Below you can find the travel information. Before choosing the best travel option please let us know, so we confirm it or give you some further information or suggestions.

3. VISA


Please inform us in case your participants require a visa in order to participate in the training. Keep in mind that it would be great to have the information until the end of August in order for us to provide the necessary documentation.




4. WEATHER

And don't forget to bring warm clothes and good shoes.




