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About B lb lzade

B lb lzade Foundation was established in 1994 in Gaziantep to support the development of civil society activities. It provides services in education, health, arts, sports, migration, environment, and solidarity, with a strong focus on youth work. The foundation collaborates with public institutions and NGOs. Our foundation organizes trainings, workshops, and seminars in various fields, including digitalization, to support the development of young people from different languages and cultures. Our goal is to equip youth with essential skills for social life, promote volunteerism, and foster a culture of peace and coexistence.

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Activities

The first week is the orientation week. During this time, volunteers get to know the foundation's volunteers, committees, and activity areas. After the orientation, every volunteer has their place of work. They take part as leaders or supporters in different fields such as media, humanitarian aid, psycho-social support for disadvantaged people, sports, arts, culinary arts, language courses, women's studies, sewing migration, project management and development, environment, cultural trips for disadvantaged youth, as well as academic studies and research.

Transportation

Most of our activities will be in our institution. We will provide shuttle buses for activities planned outside the institution. Weekend trips might be arranged by volunteers themselves with the support of mentors.



Accommodation

There are rooms for boys and girls. Participants will stay in shared rooms, each room for 2 persons. The rooms for volunteers are fully furnished with pillows, blankets, sheets. But please bring your own personal hygienic stuff for your own usage.



Insurance

Receiving organisation enrolls volunteers in HENNER insurance. Emergencies are covered, but regular checks and medicines must be paid by volunteers. Treatments at contracted hospitals are covered, with costs reimbursed upon invoices since Turkey is outside the EU. Ensure your insurance is active before travel.



Food

We provide 3 meals everyday (breakfast, lunch and dinner). The menu can be shaped according to volunteers' requests. We also have plenty of kitchens available for volunteers to cook anytime.

Gaziantep cuisine has been recognized by UNESCO as a Gastronomy City. The origin of baklava is in this city.

Accommodation

Our accomodation very convinient. Volunteers stays shared rooms 2 person each room, its right next to the foundation where most our activities takes place also the accomodation is only 150 metrs far from the tram station.

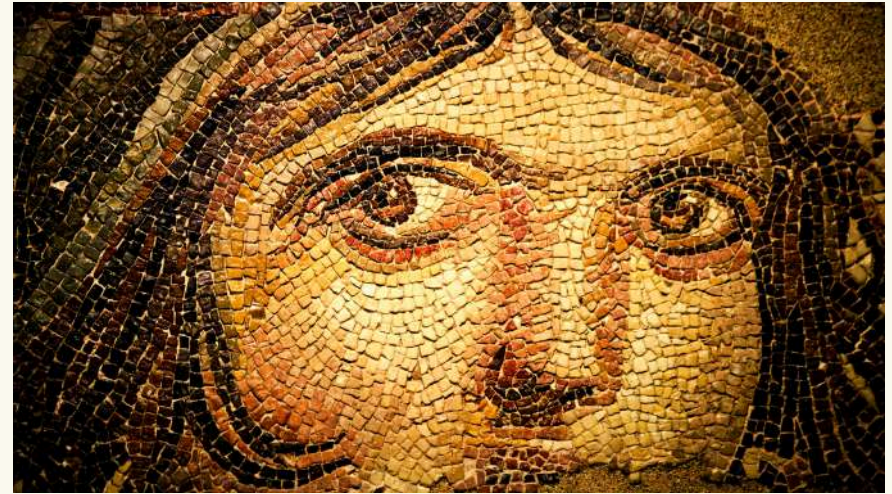

We provide pick-up service on arrival and departure for participants!

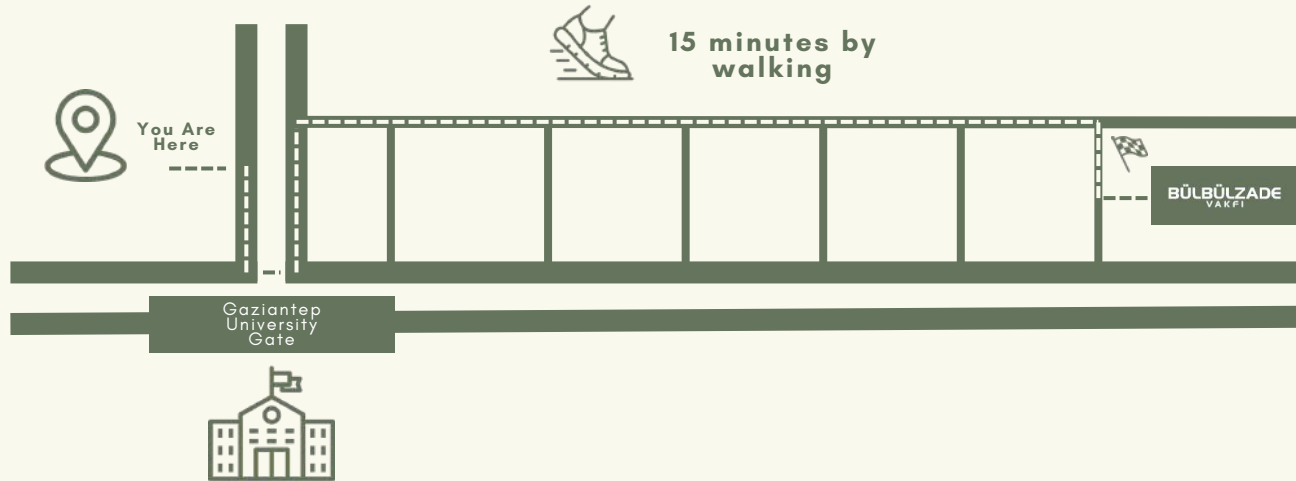
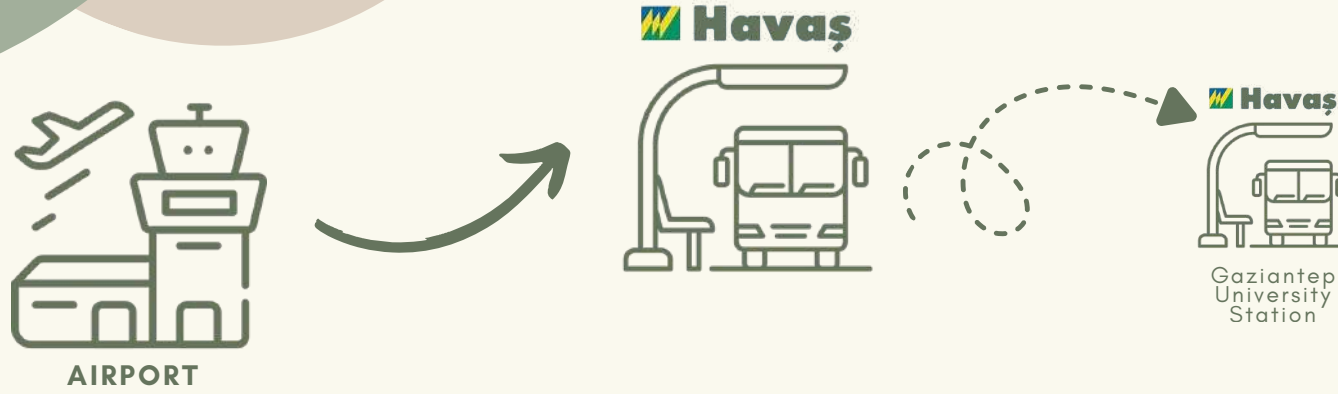
Just in case there is alternative transportation information:

Hello everyone! My name is Tanya. I'm a volunteer from Russia! In mid-March, I arrived in Gaziantep for a volunteer project. It was my second ESC project and my second time volunteering in Turkey.

As a volunteer in 2025, I experienced Ramadan firsthand in mid-March. I'd always wanted to visit a country where most people are fasting during Ramadan, and Bülbülzade Vakfı made this dream come true. This experience deepened my understanding of the cultural and religious traditions of Gaziantep's people. During this blessed time, we helped prepare iftar in the camp for earthquake victims and in Gaziantep for orphans and teachers. Several times we visited hospitable colleagues. We also joined the active work at Bülbülzade's social center.





The highlight of this project for me was working at a secondary school. This experience truly changed me—I never imagined myself working with children, as I believed I was indifferent and unskilled at teaching. Turns out, I was wrong. The kids at the school were (and are) wonderful, kind, and—most importantly—curious and smart. They truly listened to us and eagerly participated in every activity we proposed. I grew very attached to them, and I hope I taught them something useful for their future, leaving a mark on their lives.

Our mentors and the Bülbülzade team also did everything to make our leisure memorable! We visited museums, gardens, bazaars, and even went hiking and picnicking in the countryside. Turkey's nature is breathtaking—worth visiting for that alone. We explored several provinces and collected countless amazing (and sometimes extreme!) memories.

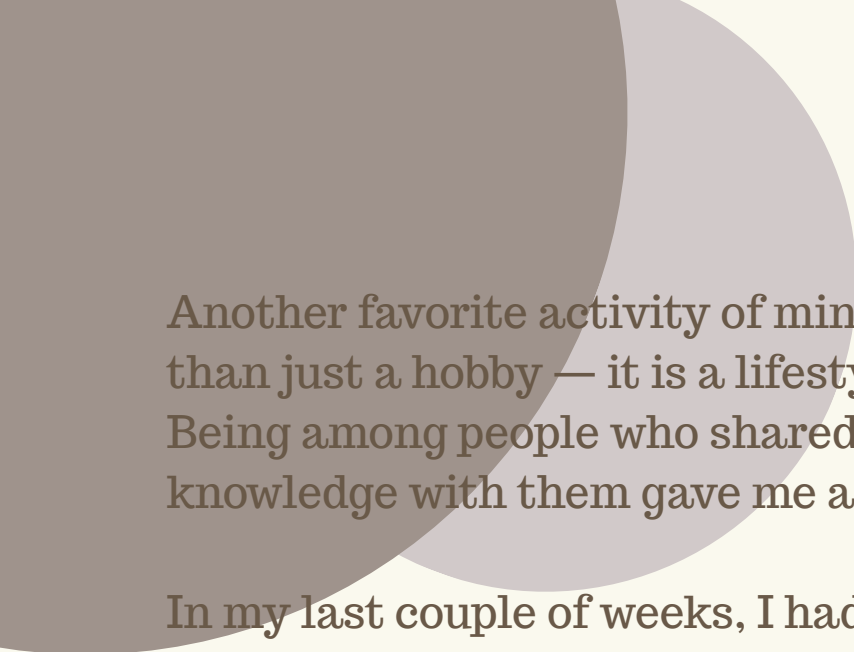


A Life-Changing Experience in Gaziantep
