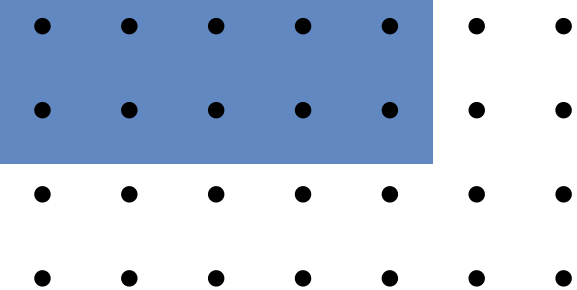

Who we are

Youth Point in “Lo Carrilet” service is an office that belongs to the municipality of Tortosa. The activity of the Youth Point (Punt Jove), is to inform and help young people so that they can choose the best options for their present and future, creating equal opportunities. Every year more youngsters use the service, which makes the program grow in terms of participation. The aim is to encourage the creation of projects and attend to the needs of young people. For this purpose, there is a Youth Information Point and the services of health, work - entrepreneurship and self-employment-, and educational guidance. A dynamic space is also implemented to offer meeting points and relationships between young people.

Espai Jove



From Espai Jove many are offered activities such as role games, artistic and music activities, conversations in another language, a tennis table, and many more!

Community empowerment



From Punt Jove (Youth Poooint) many activities and events are organized for the youth in our city with the aim of promoting social cohesion and interculturality. Some of them are related with music, art or nature.

The municipality of Tortosa

The professional technical team

...is responsible for the day-to-day management of the services.
There is one director and different social workers working on the mentioned programs.
The volunteer will be supervised by one of them.



Volunteer's tasks

HOURS: between 30 and 35h

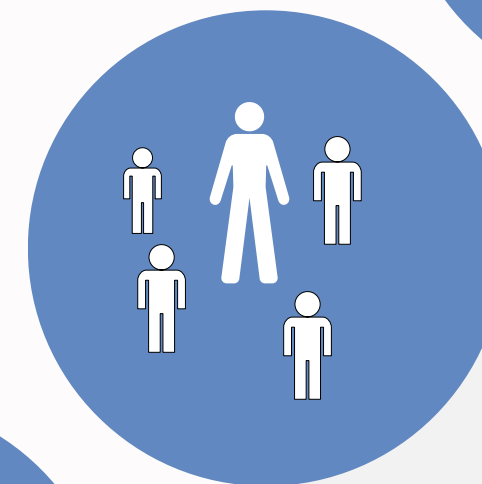
+ catalan lessons 2 h per week



Organisation of events: Assist in the tasks of organizing activities: conferences, concerts, lectures, workshops, exhibitions, competitions, festivals, tours, Christmas park, fairs, excursions, etc...



Campaign to publicize the YIP in secondary schools and universities: Assist in the preparation of the talk; in the organization of the talks schedule and to perform it.



Help to organize and dynamize activities for youth and work with them directly.



Attention, information, and training: Help to direct public attention and phone and electronic attention and social media.



Volunteer's tasks

Diffusion of ECS and local participation: the volunteers need to participate at least in 3 different talks (schools, radio, etc) to explain the experience, and to participate in 6 different local actions to get to know the community where they are living (environmental, social, cultural...)

Personal Project: Preparing your project is a compulsory activity for your personal development. Always need to coordinate with your hosting organization.

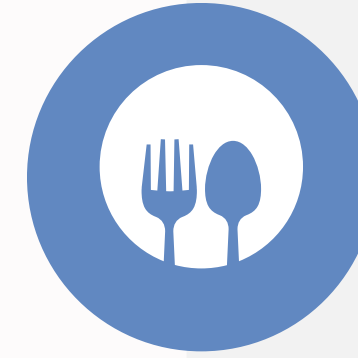




Volunteer's profile

- Is open-minded towards differences and has an unconditional respect for the others
- Is interested in working with diversity of people
- Is willing to do the tasks
- Has previous experience in volunteering at the local level
- Has a personal interest in the topic covered by the association
- Is highly motivated to learn Catalan and Spanish (VERY IMPORTANT BASIC SPANISH)
- Is highly motivated to have relations with the community

Practical arrangements



- The shopping list will be done by the volunteers
- The food will be delivered every 2 weeks by a supermarket



- Facilities and rooms (4-6 double beds) are shared.
- Free WIFI
- Sharing the house with other projects is possible.
- Deposit of 100 euros on arrival. Returned at the end if belongings are fine



- Monthly pocket money at the beginning of each month (6 euros per day)



- Working hours maximum 35 hours per week
- 2 h language per week (Catalan)
- Personal project
- If working weekends, it will be compensated during the week
- 2 days off per month



- EU citizen, bring your European Health Insurance Card. For non-EU citizens, we have to apply to Henner Insurance
- Spanish community: do not forget to bring your Social Security Number

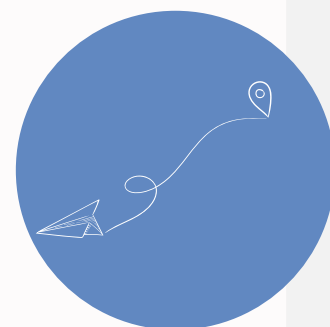


- The language course will consist of Catalan language (the Official Language in Catalonia) and it will be strengthened with language, 2 hours per week (in volunteering or formal courses)

Practical arrangements



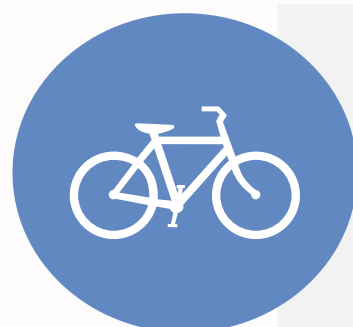
- Volunteers have a mentor. Individual mentoring and group mentoring with other volunteers are compulsory
- Volunteers need to assist with the compulsory training by the National Agency: 1 on arrival and 1 mid-term evaluation.



- Travel costs will be reimbursed after submitting tickets, bills, boarding passes, etc
- Travel costs are based on EU travel grant accordingly to the ESC program



- Visa costs can be covered. First, ask us about the assigned amount
- Ask us for the supporting letters on time
- Make sure of the procedures and dates with your embassy to obtain the visa



- Each volunteer will have a bike, helmet, and a bike lock
- On arrival, volunteers need to know that helmet (10 Euros), bike lock (10 Euros), and bike (60 Euros) are priced at 80 Euros. If volunteers lose, break, or damage the items they will need to replace them
