Description



Click for Change invites young people to reflect on how their everyday choices — both online and offline — can shape a more sustainable and responsible future. The project combines two key dimensions of today's youth experience: **digital identity** and **sustainability**.

On one side, participants will dive into the **three key roles of media**—information, education, and entertainment—while building skills in critical thinking, self-awareness, and self-organization. On the other, they will explore how simple lifestyle choices can reduce their **environmental footprint** and actively contribute to **climate action**.

Through **creative workshops**, **non-formal learning**, and collaborative **media production**, participants will explore how to live more sustainably while expressing their values and identity online.

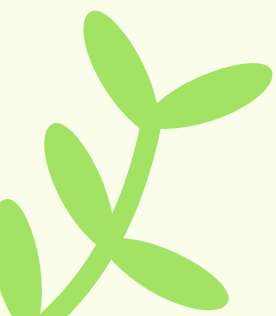

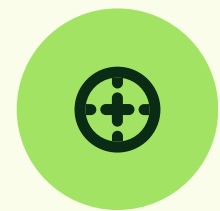

How to reach the venue



From Vilnius Airport to Train Station

Take city bus no. 1 or 2 directly to Vilnius Main Train Station (last stop from the airport).



Train/ Bus Vilnius – Trakai

Take a **bus** ([schedule here](#)) or a **train** ([schedule here](#)) from Vilnius to Trakai. Get off at the final stop “Trakai” (not Senieji Trakai).



Pick ups from Trakai

From Trakai station we will organize pick-ups to the venue. Details will be shared with you closer to the project dates.





Reimbursement

Covered costs

Food, accommodation, and programme expenses are fully covered.

Tickets & documents

Participants must buy their tickets and keep all original documents: boarding passes, invoices, and payment proofs.



Travel reimbursement

Travel costs are reimbursed up to a set limit; extra costs are covered by participants.
