# Description

Click for Change invites young people to reflect on how their everyday choices — both online and offline — can shape a more sustainable and responsible future. The project combines two key dimensions of today's youth experience: digital identity and sustainability.

On one side, participants will dive into the **three key roles of media**—information, education, and entertainment—while building skills in critical thinking, self-awareness, and self-organization. On the other, they will explore how simple lifestyle choices can reduce their **environmental footprint** and actively contribute to **climate action**.

Through **creative workshops**, **non-formal learning**, and collaborative **media production**, participants will explore how to live more sustainably while expressing their values and identity online.



# Participants

Age group

Participants are 16–18 years old, eager to learn and share new perspectives.

Group composition

12 participants + 2 leaders from Lithuania,
Denmark, Ireland, and Bulgaria.

No prior experience is required — just curiosity, motivation, and openness to new ideas.

# How to reach the venue



#### From Vilnius Airport to Train Station

Take city bus no. 1 or 2 directly to Vilnius Main Train Station (last stop from the airport).



#### Train/ Bus Vilnius - Trakai

Take a **bus** (<u>schedule here</u>) or a <u>train</u> (<u>schedule</u> <u>here</u>) from Vilnius to Trakai. Get off at the final stop "Trakai" (not Senieji Trakai).



#### Pick ups from Trakai

From Trakai station we will organize pick-ups to the venue. Details will be shared with you closer to the project dates.





# Reimbursement

#### **Cultural Evening**

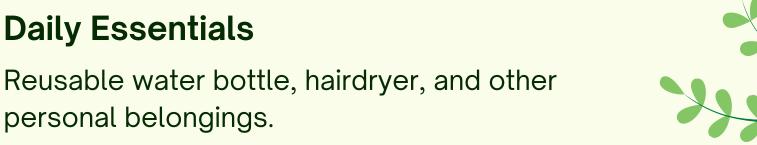
Snacks or sweets from your country, plus flags, games, songs, dances, or traditions to share.
