## Learning Methods: How You Will Learn


- Interactive Learning: Modules that combine videos, guizzes, and exercises.

## About Sadova

Sadova is a picturesque commune in Suceava County, located in the historical region of Bukovina, in north-eastern Romania. Nestled at the foothills of the Carpathian Mountains, Sadova is surrounded by rolling hills, dense forests, and clear mountain streams, making it an ideal destination for those seeking both nature and tradition. The settlement is known for its authentic rural charm and well-preserved customs, offering visitors a glimpse into the cultural richness of Bukovina. Traditional wooden houses, local crafts, and folklore festivals keep alive the spirit of the region. Agriculture and animal husbandry remain the main occupations of the inhabitants, but tourism is increasingly important due to the area's natural beauty. Sadova is an excellent starting point for exploring the nearby natural and cultural attractions of Bukovina. The commune lies on the route to the famous painted monasteries included on the UNESCO World Heritage list (such as Moldoviţa, Suceviţa, and Voroneţ), while also being close to Rarău and Giumalău mountains, well-known for hiking, winter sports, and breathtaking landscapes.

With its scenic landscapes, vibrant traditions, and proximity to both nature and history, Sadova represents the authentic spirit of Bukovina and warmly welcomes visitors to experience its unique blend of heritage and natural beauty.

# transportation

## **Main airports:**

- Bucharest (OTP)
- Suceava (SCV)
- Iași (IAS)
- Cluj-Napoca (CLJ)
- Bacău (BCM)



### **Connections to Suceava:**

If you do not have a direct flight to/from Suceava (SCV), you should consider the following:

- 1.**Train**. You can check the timetables here: CFR Călători (www.cfrcalatori.ro).
- 2.**Bus**. You can check the timetables here: Autogări. (www.autogari.ro)
- 3. Airplane. There are flights SCV OTP SCV.
- 4.Or you can ask us for **other options.**

From/ to the airport, you can take a taxi or the bus. You can ask us for details.



# How to get from the Suceava airport to the guest house in Sadova


### By public transport:

From Suceava Airport, take a taxi to Suceava Train Station (Gara Suceava) – the ride takes approx. 20 minutes and costs around 7–10 EUR (35–50 RON).

From there, you can take a regional train to Câmpulung Moldovenesc (approx. 2 hours).

Alternatively, you can go to Suceava Bus Station (Autogara) and check for buses to Câmpulung Moldovenesc.

From Câmpulung Moldovenesc, take a local taxi to Sadova – approx. 10–15 minutes, cost: 5–8 EUR (25–40 RON).



## How to get from Bucharest/lasi airport to the guest house in Sadova

### From Bucharest Airport (Henri Coandă/OTP) to Sadova, Suceava

- From the airport, take the train or shuttle to Bucureşti Gara de Nord – cost: 1–3 EUR (5–15 RON), duration: 20–40 min.
- From București Gara de Nord, take a train to Câmpulung Moldovenesc. Duration: 8–10 hours.
  - For comfort, choose a night train with couchettes (1–6 beds). Price: 150-300 RON (30-60 EUR) depending on the number of beds and class.
- From Câmpulung Moldovenesc, take a local taxi to Sadova 10– 15 minutes, cost: 5–8 EUR (25–40 RON).
- Alternative: long-distance bus services (check schedules on autogari.ro or Flixbus). Ride: 7-9 hours.

### From Iași Airport (IAS) to Sadova, Suceava

- From Iași Airport, take a taxi or shuttle to Iași Train Station (Gara lasi) – approx. 15–20 minutes, cost: 3–5 EUR (15–25 RON).
- From Iaşi Train Station, take a train to Câmpulung Moldovenesc. Duration: 3–4 hours.
  - Couchettes (1–6 beds) are available on some longer-distance trains. Price: 100-200 RON (20-40 EUR).
- From Câmpulung Moldovenesc, take a local taxi to Sadova 10– 15 minutes, cost: 5-8 EUR (25-40 RON).
- Alternative: regional buses from Iași to Suceava or directly to Câmpulung Moldovenesc (check schedules on autogari.ro).
- Other options: Flixbus or Blablacar car-sharing platforms often have routes Iași - Suceava - Câmpulung.

For participants arriving via Bucharest, please plan to travel one day in advance, as the journey by train to Câmpulung Moldovenesc/Sadova takes 8–10 hours (often overnight). The same applies for the return trip: when booking your flight tickets, make sure to allow enough time between the train journey and your flight departure.

### Weather in Sadova

November in Sadova is typically cold and damp, with average temperatures ranging from 0°C (32°F) to 8°C (46°F). The days are short, with limited sunlight, and mornings often bring frost. Rainfall is common, and towards the end of the month light snow may occur, especially in the surrounding mountains. With its chilly weather and misty landscapes, November marks the transition from autumn to the early signs of winter in Bukovina.
