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GENERAL INFO ABOUT THE PROJECT

Social Impact Lab: From Empathy to Leadership is an interactive training course for youth workers, taking place in Tykocin, Poland.

The project will gather 37 participants – 30 youth workers and 7 trainers – from 7 countries **(5 participants per country)**.

During the training, participants will explore how to co-create social projects with young people using design thinking and social storytelling methods. The activities will be based on real social challenges identified in the participants' local communities.

As a result of the training, participants will develop **10 prototypes of micro social projects, strengthen their leadership skills**, enhance empathy, and learn to identify and support young people's potential through creative and human-centered approaches.

- Youth workers, educators, or community leaders actively working with young people.
- Motivated to design and implement social impact projects in their local communities.

- Committed to sharing the outcomes of the project and implementing a small follow-up action after the mobility.

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Travel to the venue



We will be traveling by our van. If you have any questions about the trip, please read this file and feel free to contact us for any clarifications.

The training course participants will travel using the organization's vehicle. The trip will begin on November 19th from Lithuania. You are expected to arrive by the end of the same day at the venue. The return trip will be organized in the same way. We expect you to be back in Lithuania by November 28th in the second part of the day/night.

Participants will be driving the car all the way. You will need to pay for diesel and road taxes. However, these expenses will be reimbursed once you return home and present all original invoices.

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REIMBURSEMENT

Before you buy tickets please consult the choice with us! We are waiting for your travel plan until the **09.11.2025**.

Travel costs are reimbursed under the condition of participation in **all activities** up to 90 days from the date of receipt by Youth Human Impact **of the results of the project dissemination activities**, and a complete **set of documents** such as travel reimbursement forms and original tickets.

Only class II or Economy Class tickets are eligible for reimbursement of costs. Taxis, private cars ridden alone, first/ business class or any flight upgrades are not reimbursed.

You must send us a plan of your trip and you can proceed with purchasing only after our confirmation.
