THE PROJECT OBJECTIVES

Today's uncertain and rapidly changing conditions make young people's active participation in social life more important than ever. With this project, we aim to develop young people's social participation, involvement in democratic processes, and ability to generate solutions to social problems. Participants will learn to develop creative solutions to the challenges encountered in post-normal times by coming together with peers from different countries, and will become role models who make a difference in their own social circles. Our project, designed within the framework of Erasmus+ youth mobility, aims to strengthen young people's skills in solidarity, cooperation and intercultural understanding.

► PROJECT ACITIVITIES

Various seminars, expert presentations, group workshops and cultural events will be organised as part of the project. Firstly, ice-breaking activities and introductions to participating organisations will be held to facilitate communication and interaction among participants. Subsequently, participants will be divided into groups and take part in project development workshops. These workshops will aim to generate ideas and develop practices to increase young people's social participation in post-normal times. Additionally, as part of eco-friendly initiatives, tree planting, nature walks and environmental conservation activities will be organised, enhancing participants' environmental awareness and understanding of sustainable living. In addition, tours will be organised to promote intercultural awareness by showcasing Gaziantep's cultural heritage. Participants will have the opportunity to interact with different cultures while discovering the city's history and cultural values.

*ACCOMODATION AND MEALS

The seminars, conferences and other sessions to be held as part of the project will take place at the Bülbülzade Foundation building, where the Bülbülzade Organization is based. Participants' accommodation and meal requirements will be met at Zade Life Hotel, ensuring a comfortable and pleasant environment throughout the project. Additionally, each participant will receive daily individual support to cover their accommodation, meals, and other needs.

**TRANSPORTATION

Participants' travel expenses incurred during the project period will be covered in accordance with the distance band specified in the Erasmus+ Programme Guide and will be provided to participants through their sending organisations, along with the necessary documents.
