**TARGET GROUP:**

**The mobility will take the form of a seminar attended by 40 participants (youth workers )(> 18 years old) +  
2 facilitators , representatives of min 10 organizations from 10 countries.**



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# SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES OF THE PROJECT

**Objective 1:** To increase the quality of youth services provided by at least 10 participating organisations (including a minimum of 2 newly involved organisations), by strengthening their capacity to use modern, applicable and inclusive green educational approaches, by 31.08.2026.

**Objective 2:** To improve the professional preparation of at least 40 youth workers from a minimum of 10 organisations from Programme Countries, through participation in an international seminar focused on environmental education, sustainable development and climate change, based on the exchange of experience and collaborative learning, by 31.08.2026.

**Objective 3:** To create, adapt, test and validate, during the international mobility, a set of at least 5 green, experiential and inclusive educational activities, starting from the participants' real practices and adapted to a future scenario, designed for working with young people with fewer opportunities.

**Objective 4:** To increase the level of environmental information, awareness and sensitisation among young people, especially those with fewer opportunities, by facilitating access to educational and visual materials created by youth workers during the mobility and disseminated both in local contexts and online, through digital channels and common project hashtags, by 31.08.2026.

Stage of dissemination – results: 22.03.2026 - 31.08.2026.



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# PARTICIPANTS' PROFILE :

**40 Youth workers (20 girls and 20 boys), (citizens or residents in the country of sending) age: (> 18 years old), of which 8 with reduced opportunities:**

- Youth workers - unemployed, including young NEETs;
- Youth workers coming from rural areas;
- Youth workers from geographically isolated backgrounds;
- Youth workers facing economic obstacles;
- Youth workers coming from migrant families, refugees, ethnic minority groups.

**Youth worker active in the organization;**

**Age over 18 years;**

**Stable domicile or resident in the country of referral;**

**Secondary or higher education in the field of inclusion and environmental protection and / or secondary education would be an asset;**

**Experience working with young people with fewer opportunities;**

**Communication skills in English; Knowledge in the field of Erasmus + and ESC Program;**

**Non-formal and informal learning skills;**

**Motivation to participate in the project.**



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# PARTICIPANTS, SELECTION, COMMUNICATION

Each partner will select 2 youth workers + 2 reserve participants on the basis of the above criteria;

Each partner organization will send to the Coordinator its list of participants with names, passports/IDs and contact details, together with the travel schedules (dates and times of arrival and departure);

Each participant will fill out a questionnaire sent by the Coordinator.



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# THE PARTICIPANTS WILL PREPARE FOR THE MOBILITY:

A presentation of their country (with traditions, customs, attractions ...) under the most original format (recommendations: movies, ppts, photos);

Making a presentation of good practices which includes sm, non-formal methods of working with young people with fewer opportunities specific to their own organizations.

The mobility activities will be carried out according to the activities plan, using non-formal methods (public café, open space, brainstorming, debate, round table, case study, workshops, practical activities, study visits, outdoor activities, hiking, meeting with representatives from the local community, cultural evenings, debates, analysis conclusions and others proposed by the participants), in a multicultural atmosphere of mutual respect, favoring the achievement of the purpose and objectives of the project.

Information sessions; Workshops in the community- application of methods and techniques learned at the seminar;

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# MOBILITY LOCATION

•Romania: HOTEL HOREZU 3\* from Horezu Resort; •Address: •Str. Capitan Maldar, no 1 ,  
Horezu Resort, Vâlcea County, Romania. GPS: 45.1444130, 23.9939601.

Short description: Hotel Horezu is classified as three star hotel.

Accommodation will be provided in twin rooms with separate beds, private bathrooms,  
TV, internet.

Other facilities: Wi-fi, parking, conference room; restaurant, laundry facilities, terrace,  
football and tennis courts.

Within the Touristic Complex operates a restaurant, bar, sweet shop and a recreational  
base consisting of tennis court on clay surface and minifootball pitch covered with  
synthetic surface, equipped with nocturnal installation.

Meals will be served at the restaurant, inside the hotel: full board (3 meals / day).

In Romania, the participants can benefit from free public health insurance, like any Romanian citizen.

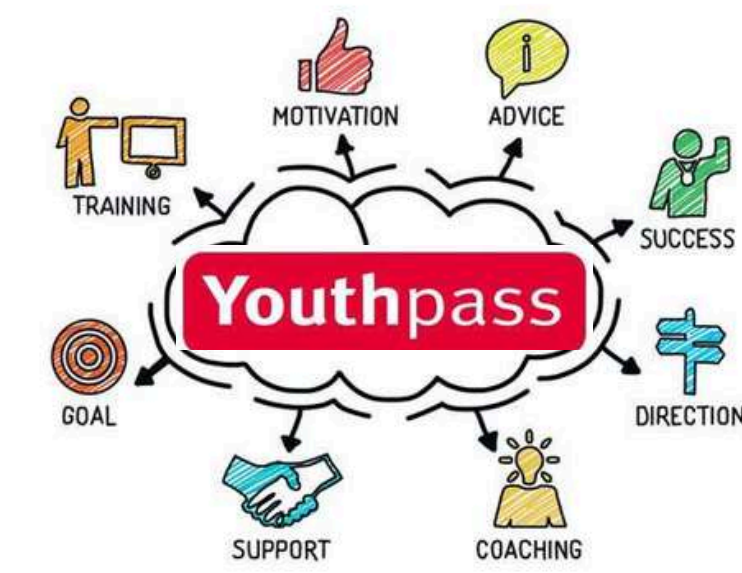
The European Health Card is recommended.

**GREEN-PRO – Green Professional Development for Youth Workers** project, proposes the validation of non-formal and informal learning and the skills gained by each participant, through the European Youthpass Certificate.

Participation at the programme's activities is **COMPULSORY**.  
Each day of activities will not exceed 6 hours (3 hours AM, 3 hours PM ).  
Pause at every 90 minutes.

Each participant has the obligation to upload the mobility report in the Beneficiary Module, immediately after returning to his country.



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# TRANSPORT PROCEDURE

As a safety measure,  
please apply the following procedure regarding the buying of the travel tickets :  
Select the ticket (the most economical);  
Inform us regarding your selection;  
Buy the tickets only after our confirmation.

The travel expenses will be reimbursed via bank transfer to the bank accounts of each partner organization, after all the requested travel documents: invoices, receipts, tickets, boarding passes will be provided to us on their original forms, concerning both arrival and departure.

To avoid exceeding the travel budget or the risk of not finding a green means of transport, it is recommended to buy tickets at least 4 weeks before the mobility.

# SEE YOU IN ROMANIA !!!

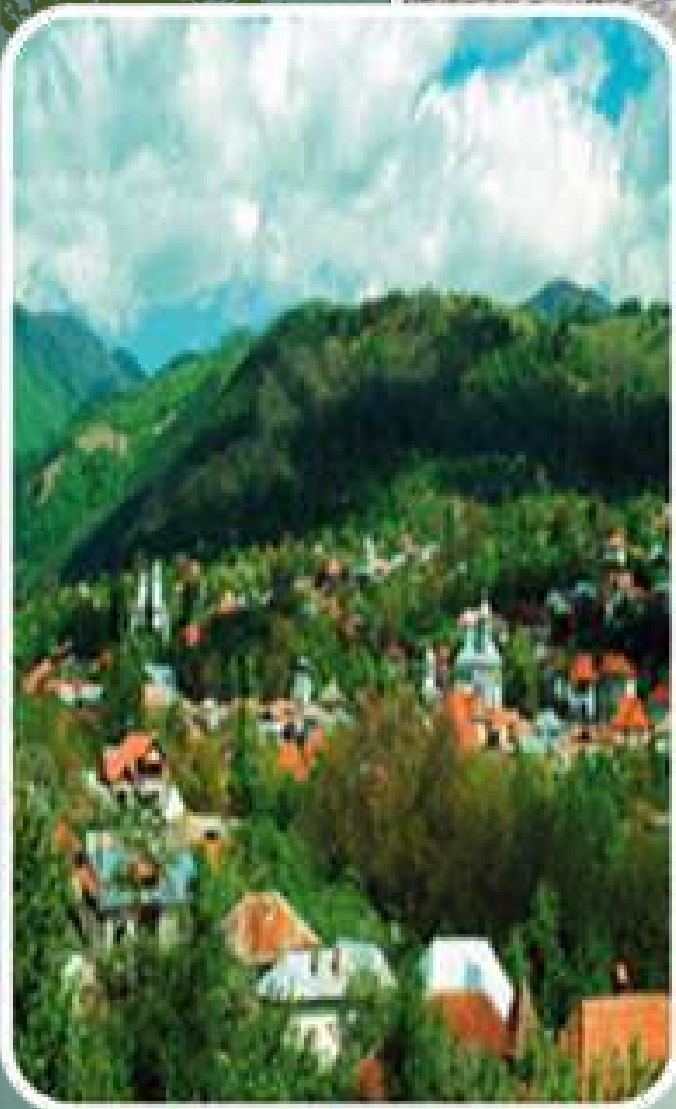
Mobility (8 days), Horezu Romania, during:
