
Basic Information

What is this project about?

By equipping youth workers with the skills to design and implement escape rooms, the project provides them with a versatile, creative tool for more interactive, relevant and effective activities. This innovation not only improves the overall quality of youth work, but also aligns with the Erasmus+ programme's focus on modernising non-formal education with new techniques and technologies.

The key objective of the project is to equip youth workers with practical, applicable skills that they can use in their daily work. The skills that youth workers will gain will enable them to create activities that encourage critical thinking, teamwork and creativity among young people. By incorporating elements of digital escape rooms, the project supports youth workers in adapting to hybrid and digital environments, ensuring that their practices remain relevant in a rapidly changing world. One of the central goals of the project is also to promote inclusion and diversity in youth work practices. Escape rooms offer a unique opportunity to address these topics through interactive, collaborative scenarios that foster empathy, cultural awareness and understanding.

The project aims to inspire and empower young people through more engaging, interactive and meaningful youth work.

Who are We looking for?



- 3 participants from each country. Please try to keep the genders balanced.
- The accommodation is unfortunately not suitable for wheelchairs.
- Participants will be youth workers, teachers and trainers/facilitators actively involved in non-formal education and youth inclusion activities, professionals or volunteers from organisations working with diverse groups of young people, including those with fewer opportunities, NEETs (not in education, employment or training) and individuals from marginalised communities.
- The group will also include individuals with varying levels of experience in gamification and escape rooms.
- You need to have European Health Card (or medical insurance)



Travel plan and finance:

100% of your traveling costs (within the budget) will be reimbursed with the condition that the person has all the bills, tickets and boarding passes (when traveling by a plane) to present to us.

Participants should prepare all the bills, tickets and boarding passes and upload to a Google Drive.



Participants need to find most optimal travel possibility to Markovci (**Municipality of Šalovci**), Slovenia. - be careful, there are two MARKOVCI in Slovenia! :P - we are staying in the “head of the chicken” (check the shape of Slovenia :P) The best way is to fly to Budapest and then take train to Szentgotthard. Check also flights to Vienna and Ljubljana.

We will do some sightseeing in Pomurje region.




:Food:

If you have special food requirements (vegetarian, celiac, allergies, etc.), **please, inform us beforehand.**




We will try to accommodate your food requirements, but sometimes that is not possible, so we **suggest you bring some ingredients with you.**

What to bring?




Lots of positive energy,
