# Project context

Climate change, environmental degradation, and sustainability challenges are among the most pressing global issues facing today's societies. Young people are increasingly exposed to complex and sometimes contradictory messages related to sustainability, often shaped by political narratives, media discourse and commercial interests.

According to the latest reports of the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC), the world is approaching critical ecological thresholds, with significant impacts on ecosystems, human well-being and future generations. These challenges require not only technical solutions, but also informed, critical and responsible civic engagement.

Sustainability Beyond Borders: Awareness to Action **aims to empower young** people to understand sustainability as a multidimensional concept, going beyond slogans and simplistic narratives, and to translate awareness into concrete actions at both the local and European levels.

# Project Objectives

## **Understanding Sustainability Multidimensionally**

Our project aims to deepen participants' awareness of sustainability, emphasising its multifaceted nature and the interconnectedness of social, environmental, and economic dimensions.

## **Strengthening GreenComp Competences**

We will conduct workshops and case studies to enhance critical thinking and promote green competencies, equipping participants with the necessary skills for active citizenship in sustainability initiatives.

## **Countering Greenwashing Effectively**

Participants will learn to identify greenwashing practices, developing a critical, data-driven approach to assess sustainability claims and make informed choices in their communities.

## **Thinking globally, acting locally**

The participants will follow up locally with an event on their own initiative and capacity.

# Who can apply

- **4 participants**, 18–26 years old, per country
- **1 Group Leader**: Age 18+, no upper age limit
- Participants with **Fewer Opportunities**: Each national group must include at least **2 participants** with fewer opportunities.
- **Motivation & Interest**: Participants should be highly motivated and interested in environmental sustainability. A willingness to learn and contribute to environmental action is essential.
- **Engagement Beyond the Exchange**: Participants shall actively engage in the project's follow-up.
- **Gender Balance**: Each group should aim for a gender-balanced composition. Non-binary participants are **welcomed and included**.
- **Openness to Intercultural and Interactive Learning**: Participants should be willing to engage with diverse perspectives, share knowledge, and participate in group discussions, activities, and team projects. This is a Youth Exchange: **non-formal educational** activities and **peer learning** are the core of the project's rationale.

# Travel Options to Naples

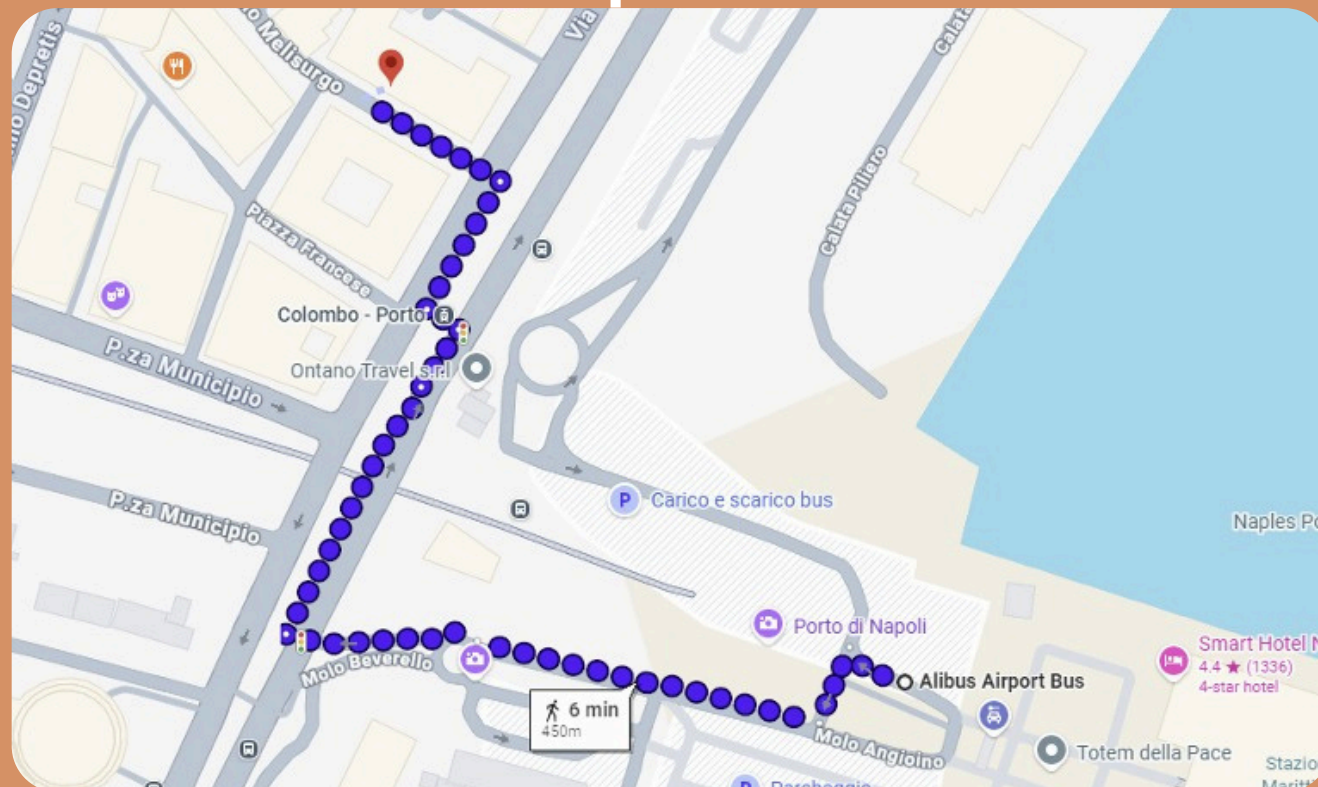
**Naples International Airport** (NAP–Capodichino) is the main gate way for international travellers. From the Airport, we suggest taking the Alibus to **Naples Port**. It costs 5€ and gets you within a **6-minute walk** of the Hostel.

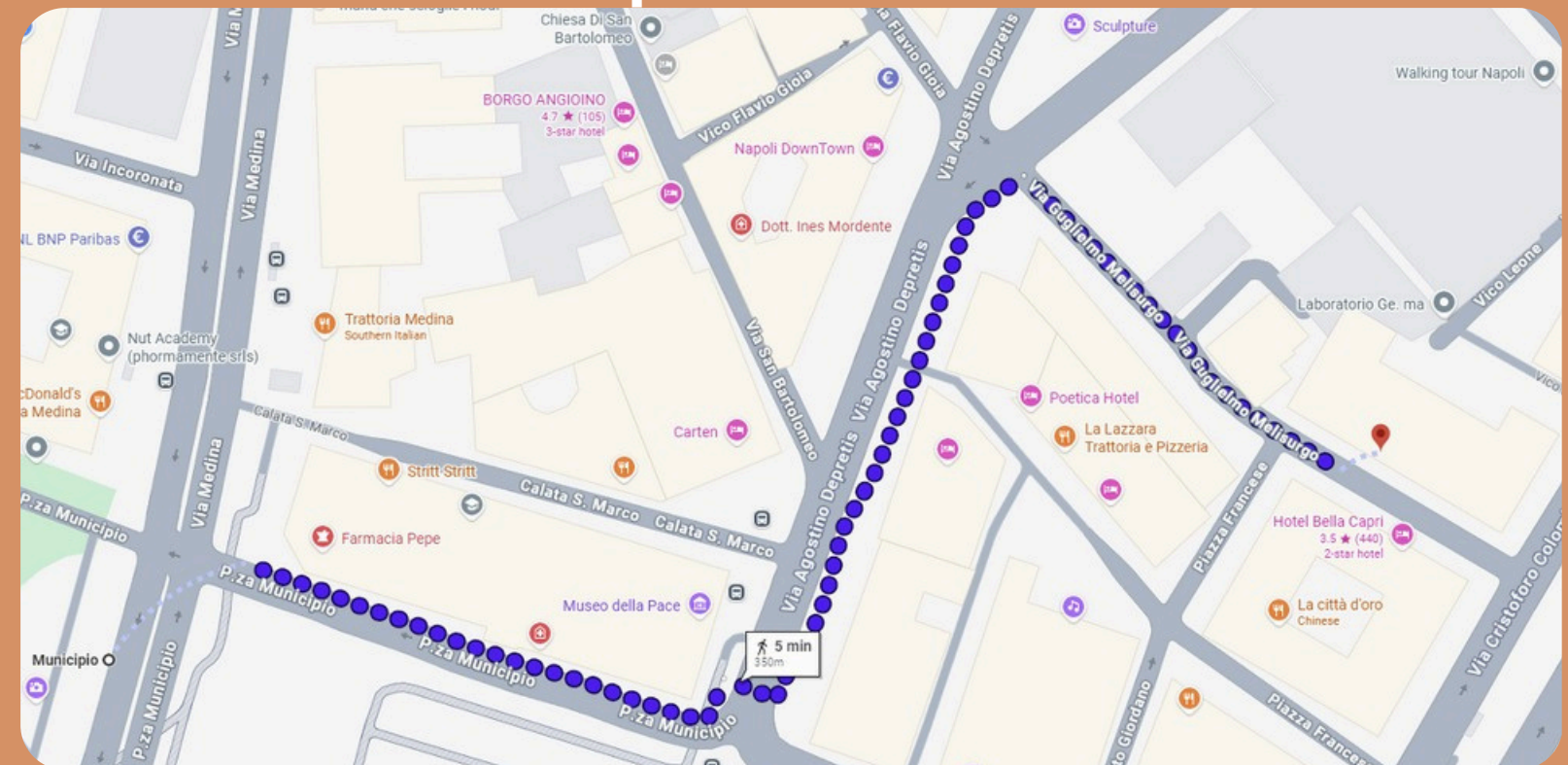
## Arriving by Train at Napoli Centrale Station

# Reimbursement conditions

Please send your travel proposals to your Sending Organisation for approval BEFORE purchasing them!

Remember to **keep all travel documents**, such as flight tickets and receipts, in their original, paper form. You will need them to claim your reimbursement! **Note: Ryanair no longer issues a PDF boarding pass, so make a screenshot with all the boarding information before your flight.**

To receive your reimbursement, you need to send all travel documents to our organisation. We will refund you up to the maximum travel budget(to Italy and back). Reimbursement will be made to your sending NGO, which will then transfer the amount to you. **If you spend less, you will be refunded for the real costs. If you spend more, you will be reimbursed up to the maximum.**

**You will get more precise instructions at the end of the activities.**

We have **availability** for you to sustain a **Green Travel** with a bigger budget and two days of travel. Green travel refers to the use of **low-emission transport** options, such as buses, trains, bikes, or carpooling, **for most of the journey**. You will still need to share your proposed route with us and keep track of all expenses duly justified.

## Standard Travel Budget

Spain – maximum 309€

Greece – maximum 309€

Lithuania – maximum 309€

Ireland – maximum 395€

Participants **must complete** the questionnaires and assessments, **participate** in the scheduled activities, and **follow up** with a **small local educational event** within their own community to receive reimbursement. Photos **of participants with the YE logo we provide** will serve as verification. **Cooperation is welcomed:** you can do it as a national group if feasible.

# Before the mobility

You will have to complete simple tasks:

- a. **Answer the first questionnaire** about your attitude, skills, personal motivation and knowledge assessment.
- b. You have to **share with us the itinerary** of your travel to Naples and **wait for our confirmation**.
- c. Participate in a **know-each-other** videocall and gather your contributions on expectations, logistical issues, and participatory suggestions.
- d. **Communicate your needs, participate in the WhatsApp group and keep track of our e-mails.**

## Very important to know before departure

- ✓ **Valid Passport/ID** Before leaving, please ensure your travel document is valid for the entire duration of the exchange.
- ✓ **European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) or Travel Insurance** Arrange your EHIC or private insurance for medical coverage.
- ✓ **Power Adapter** Italy uses Type F/L sockets (230V, 50Hz), so bring an adapter if needed.
- ✓ **Prepare for Intercultural Night** Bring something that represents your country (a small flag, food, traditional items, or a fun cultural activity to share).
