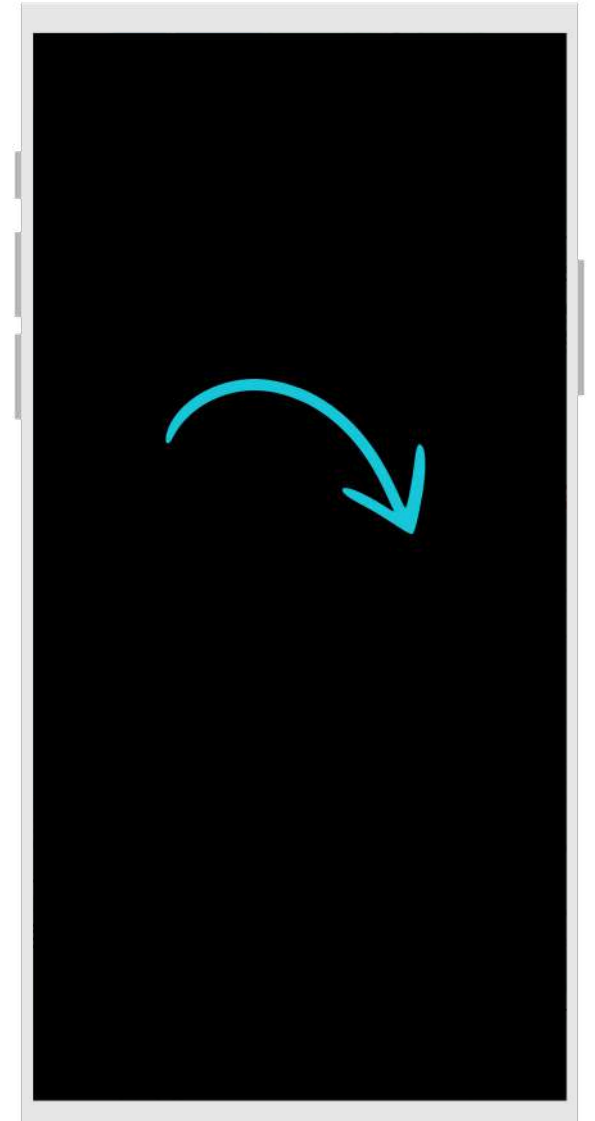


# LOCATION

The hosting site includes several buildings for accommodation, an activity area, farm animals, and various facilities adapted to the project.
