Summary

GenAI: Digital Reality Check is an international Erasmus+ Youth Exchange that brings together young people from different countries to explore the growing role of digital technologies and Artificial Intelligence in their daily lives. The project addresses how AI-generated content, algorithms, and data usage influence communication, access to information, and participation in society, with a strong focus on digital awareness, critical thinking, and responsible online behaviour.

The project promotes inclusion and diversity by creating a safe and accessible learning environment where young people with different backgrounds, abilities, and experiences can participate equally. Through digital youth work approaches, virtual components, and non-formal learning methods, participants actively engage with topics such as digital safety, prevention of online bullying, and ethical use of technology. Creativity, art, and cultural expression are integrated into the programme as tools for reflection, dialogue, and self-expression, allowing participants to explore digital topics in an innovative and human-centred way. By the end of the exchange, young people are empowered to use digital technologies consciously, express their voices creatively, and contribute to a more inclusive, responsible, and informed digital future.

Each country should prepare at least two energizers – short interactive games and/or sport activity. It will take place every day before breakfast, or before activities and it should last about 15 minutes.

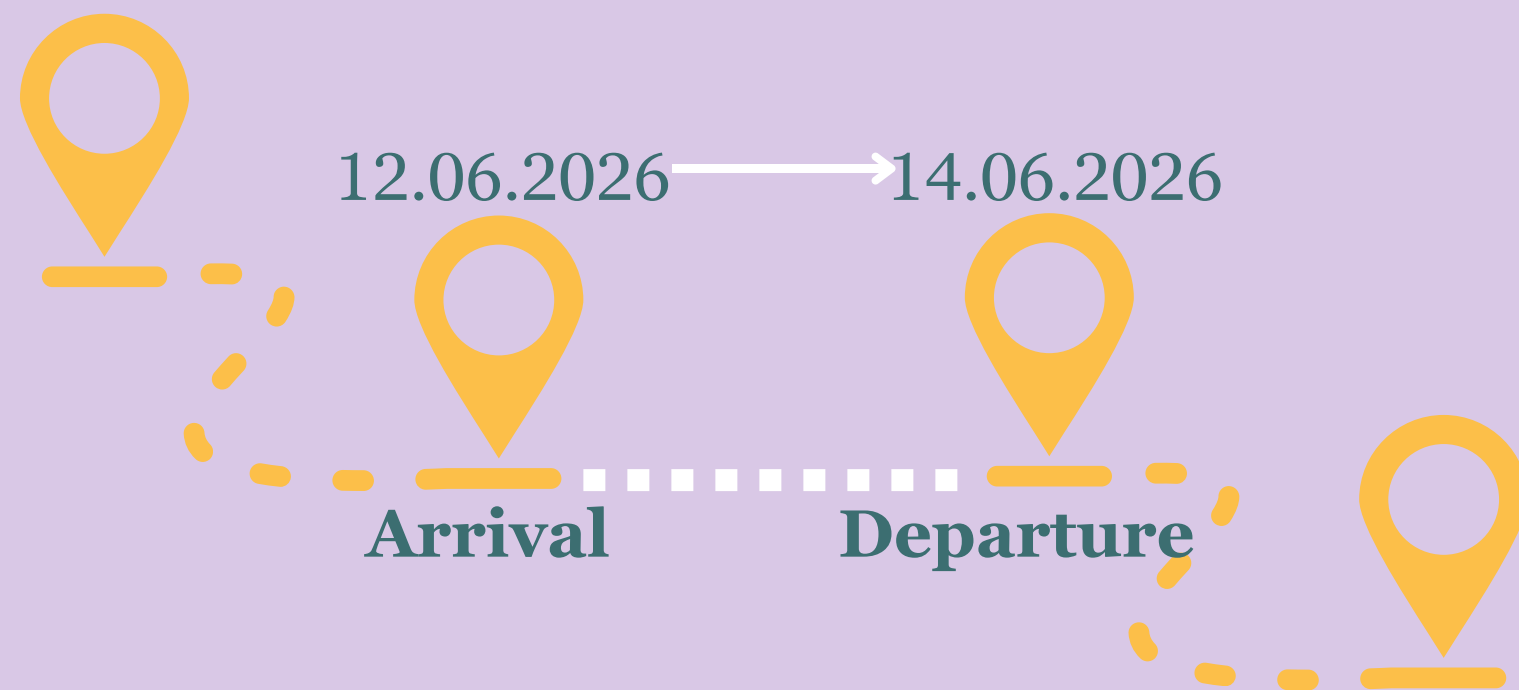

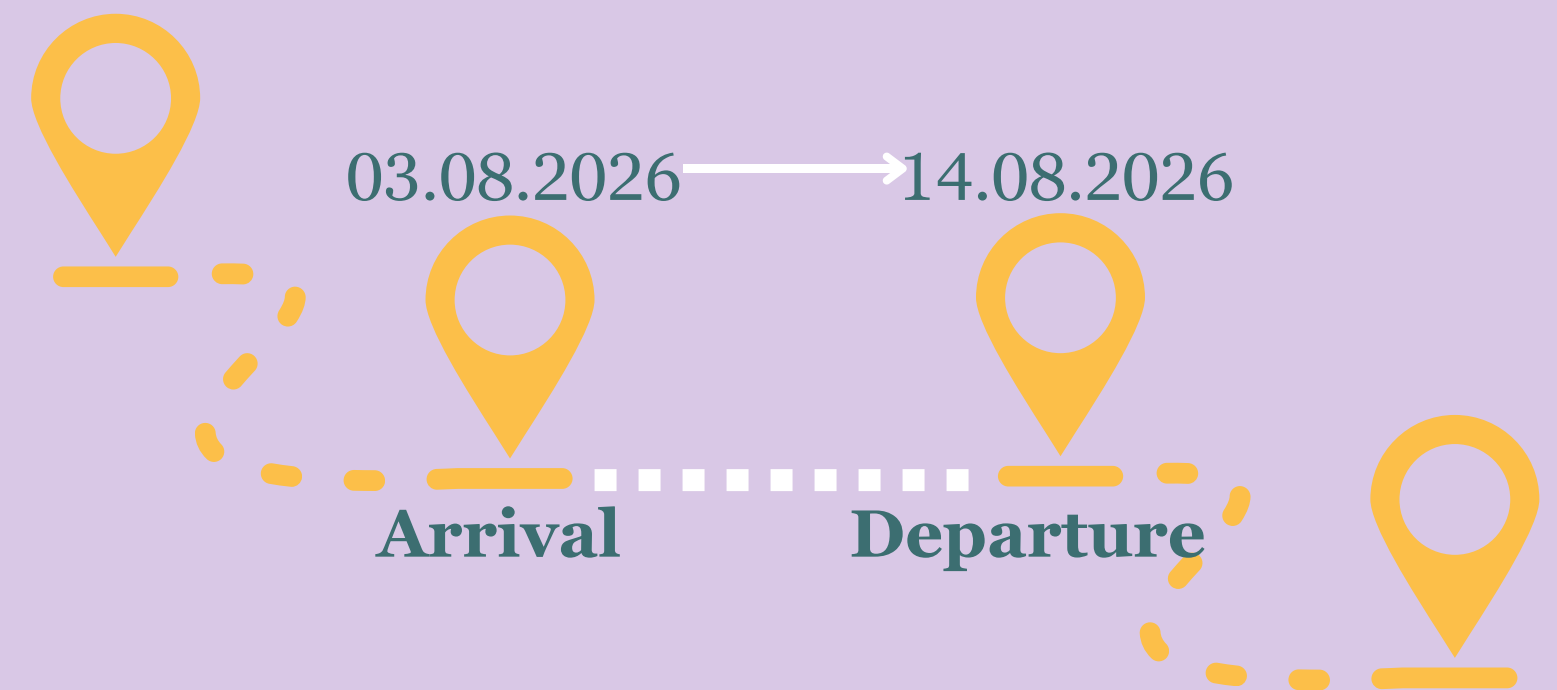

Accommodation & Venue

Participants will be accommodated at Europahaus Pulkau.

Participants will be accommodated in gender divided rooms. There will be 3 / 6 / 12 people per room. The rooms are provided with bathrooms (washbasin and shower). The toilet is shared on the floor.

Room assignments will be arranged to mix participants from different countries, encouraging intercultural exchange. As this is a new Erasmus experience, be ready to share your time and space with peers from various cultural backgrounds.

Please do not forget to keep all your boarding passes, invoices, bus/train/metro tickets in order for them to be reimbursed!!! During the project you will fill in reimbursement forms. Costs that are not declared with relevant documents, will not be reimbursed!!!

Reimbursement process!

Pre-requisites: All expenses have to be discussed and approved by us in advance. You need to collect all documents related to your traveling from your place of living to the project venue. You can use only the following means of transport and provide the following documents:

Airplane - Booking confirmation/ e-Ticket (that you receive on your email), Invoice (you ask the Airlines/ agency you used and get it from them) and Boarding Passes (you have to have boarding passes of all flights you take | Screenshots and pictures are not accepted | Either you send us digital Boarding Passes (PDF... not a screenshot of it) or if you have a physical one, you bring it in hand or send it to us by post).

Bus - receipts and tickets (in case it is an intercity bus, you have to have a ticket indicating your seat).

Train - receipts and tickets (in case it is an intercity Train, you have to have a ticket indicating your seat).

Tram/ Metro - receipts and tickets. *You are only allowed to have Economy class tickets... with no extra services except luggage. TAXIs will not be reimbursed.

Reimbursement Form: You will fill in a reimbursement form all your travel expenses. You have to introduce all relevant proofs of expenses in case they already happened, or send the document after the project, in case you will make that expenses while departing. For the currency conversion, Erasmus+ currency converter will be used.

*You do not add expenses to the form which cannot be proved by relevant documents.

Reimbursement Date: Reimbursement will be done after the activity of the project is finished. It will take several weeks and will be executed in 2-3 weeks after providing all relevant reimbursement documents and dissemination/ visibility proofs.

Reimbursement Method: Reimbursement will be made via a bank transfer to the account one / two transfer(s) per national team. In case there is a bank commission fee, it will be covered by participants.

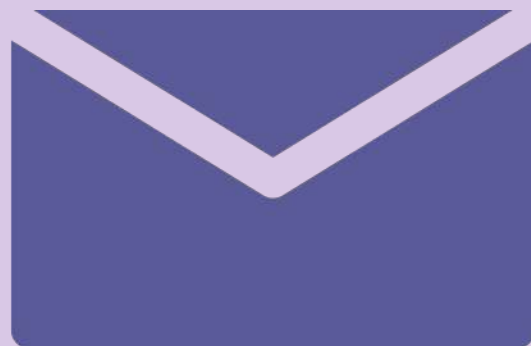
Essentials for the Exchange

Must-bring check list:

- **a valid personal document: Identity card or passport;**
- **health insurance: EHIC (European health insurance card) or other health insurance valid abroad;**
- **If you have any allergies (to dust, pollen and other plants), please take the appropriate medicine with you.**
- comfortable clothes and shoes for both situations – warm and chill weather and be prepared in case of raining. We suggest you bring along mosquito protection and sunscreen to ensure your comfort while staying in Austria. In July in Austria is the average temperature is 30°C;
- personal hygiene toiletries;
- Board games (if you have some);
- Laptop (at least one per national team);
