1. PROJECT INTRODUCTION

Climate Zero is an international KA153 seminar project designed with a focus on climate adaptation. The project aims to bring together youth workers, trainers, civil society representatives, and practitioners to address the implications of climate adaptation across the industry, agriculture, and tourism sectors.


Throughout the seminar, participants will enhance their knowledge and skills regarding climate adaptation through expert presentations, non-formal education methods, and collaborative working processes. The resulting outcomes will be transferable to youth work and future Erasmus+ projects.



2. PROJECT OBJECTIVES

The primary objectives of the Climate Zero project are as follows:

- To increase the level of knowledge and awareness of youth workers regarding climate adaptation.
- To introduce current approaches to climate adaptation in the industry, agriculture, and tourism sectors.
- To strengthen the capacity of youth workers to develop activities and projects themed around climate adaptation.
- To support cooperation and networking among organizations operating at an international level.
- To ensure the development of viable and innovative project ideas through the Ideathon methodology.

3. WHY ERZURUM?

Erzurum is one of the regions where the effects of climate change can be clearly observed and where climate adaptation is of critical importance.

Key features of the city:

- Harsh continental climate conditions and long winter periods.
- An economic structure based on agriculture and livestock.
- Winter and nature tourism potential directly affected by climate change.
- A strategic location in the Eastern Anatolia Region in terms of climate resilience.

Holding the Climate Zero seminar in Erzurum will provide participants with the opportunity to observe and evaluate climate adaptation on-site.


4. PARTICIPANT PROFILE

The seminar is designed for participants who fit the following profile:

- Youth workers and youth leaders. Staff
- and trainers working in civil society organizations (NGOs). Representatives of
- institutions working in the fields of climate, environment, and sustainability. Aged 18 and over, with 30 participants in total (2-3 participants from each organization).

Expectations from participants:

- Basic experience in the field of youth work.
- Interest in climate change and sustainability topics.
- Motivation for active participation in group work and the ideathon process.



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5. METHOD AND APPROACH

The project will be implemented using a methodology based on non-formal education. The methods to be used include:

- Expert presentations and Q&A sessions.
- Interactive workshop activities.
- Sharing of best practice examples.
- Group work and discussions.
- Ideathon (idea development marathon).
- Daily evaluation and reflection sessions.

Active participation from all participants is expected throughout the entire program.

6. ACTIVITY PROGRAM

7. TRAVEL AND REIMBURSEMENT RULES

Participants' travel expenses will be covered in accordance with the Erasmus+ Program distance bands and the rules of the national agency.

- Reimbursements will be made after full participation in the activity is ensured and all required documents are submitted.

8. ACCOMMODATION AND MEALS

- Participants will be accommodated in a hotel or guest house in Erzurum.
- Rooms may be double or triple occupancy.
- Breakfast, lunch, dinner, and coffee breaks will be provided on activity days. Special dietary requirements must be communicated in advance.

9. WORKING LANGUAGE

The working language of the seminar will be English. Participants are expected to have a level of English proficiency that allows for active participation in group work and discussions.

10. YOUTHPASS CERTIFICATE

A Youthpass Certificate will be awarded to all participants who ensure full participation in the activity.
