



## IN A NUTSHELL

Challenge-Based Learning (CBL) is a **multidisciplinary approach** in higher education that engages students with **real-world issues** through **collaboration** with peers, educators, and external stakeholders. This process involves three iterative phases: **engage, investigate, and act**. CBL benefits students by **enhancing motivation, skill development, and understanding of their professional fields**. For educators, it offers valuable opportunities for **professional growth**. Finally, universities strengthen **their integration with local social actors, contributing to urgent societal matters**.



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
## PROJECT OVERVIEW

Training course organised by Positive Impact Center (Poland) within our long-term “E-Educators” series under Erasmus+ accreditation. The project aims to equip participants with the pedagogical framework of CBL and the digital tools necessary to deploy these scenarios online. The workshops will cover:

- The core pedagogy of Challenge-Based Learning.
- Designing effective CBL scenarios and lesson plans.
- Digital tools for remote and hybrid deployment.

### **By the end of this 7-day journey, participants will:**

- Master the CBL framework: Engage, Investigate, and Act.
- Distinguish between "pseudo-tasks" and genuine challenges that drive student motivation.
- Harness AI and digital tools to synthesize complex information and publish learning journeys.
- Facilitate experiential reflection to ensure the "doing" turns into "learning."
- Translate their physical designs into digital environments: the course concludes with the published websites with CBL scenarios created by participants.




## PROFILE OF THE PARTICIPANT

This course is designed for Architects of Learning. It is a high-energy, "learning-by-doing" intensive for:

- Educators and Teachers looking to move away from lecture-style teaching toward student-led inquiry
- Youth Workers & Non-Formal Educators who need to design impactful, real-world social challenges for diverse groups
- Future Educators wanting to master the intersection of High Performance Learning (HPL) and digital pedagogy.

Moreover, participants must be:

- Residents of Poland, France, Germany, Lithuania, Albania, Greece, Italy or Portugal.
- 18+ years old (no upper age limit).
- Able to communicate in English.





## ACCOMMODATION

The activity will take place at “Knieja” in Rajgród, Poland. Rajgród is a peaceful small town surrounded by stunning lakes and forests 🌿 - a perfect place for reflection, learning, and creative collaboration.

## ROOMS

Participants will be accommodated in triple rooms, divided by gender.



## **ARRIVAL**

Participants should arrive in Warsaw Chopin Airport (alternatively - Modlin Airport) on **April 17th**. Then, the private bus  will take participants to the venue in Rajgród. Pick up location  will be Warsaw Chopin Airport around 19:00 (to be confirmed).

## **DEPARTURE**

Participants will leave Rajgród on **April 25th** after breakfast.  
 The bus tickets to Warsaw will be arranged by the organizers. There will be one extra travel day for participants who travel by plane - those participants will stay an extra night in Warsaw and leave Poland on **April 26th**.



## TRAVEL REIMBURSEMENT


The cost of a bus to/from Rajgród will be covered by the organizers.

Your other travel costs will be reimbursed up to:

- ✓ 50 EUR for participants from Poland
- ✓ 100 EUR for participants from Lithuania
- ✓ 200 EUR for participants from Greece, Albania, France, Italy, Germany
- ✓ 250 EUR for participants from Portugal

## OTHER COSTS

- ✓ Participants are responsible for covering their health & travel insurance.
- ✓ Accommodation & meals during the stay in Rajgród will be **fully covered**.
- ✓ Accommodation on the last night in Warsaw (extra day for participants who travel by plane) will be covered. Meals on that day will **NOT** be covered.



## STAY IN WARSAW

The activities will finish on April 25th, however participants who travel by plane will have an additional travel day - April 26th. On April 25th, you will go by bus to Warsaw, the capital of Poland, where you can enjoy your last evening in Poland. Accommodation for that night will be provided and covered by the hosting organization.

**IMPORTANT!**

Meals during your stay in Warsaw will **not** be covered. Participants are responsible for their own meals on this day. This is participants' contribution to the project.


