RULES OF THE EXCHANGE

BALLADE CANNOT REFUND PARTICIPANTS WHO DON'T OBEY TO THESE RULES

- **Do not bring strong alcohol to the camping area.**
- **Do not use, carry, or possess any kind of drugs at any time during travel or stay.**
- **Accept responsibility to pay for any damage caused to other people or material assets.**
- **Acknowledge that this is a learning and sharing experience, not a tourist trip.**
- **Submit travel documents to the organizer (NGO Ballade) in one PDF file, including an Excel file summarizing expenses, and all bills, tickets, and boarding passes, in order to receive travel cost reimbursement.**
- **Grant permission for the hosting organization to use photographs for dissemination of project results on social media.**
- **Understand that participants who do not follow these rules may not be eligible for reimbursement by NGO Ballade.**



RULES OF THE EXCHANGE

BALLADE CANNOT REFUND PARTICIPANTS WHO DON'T OBEY TO THESE RULES

- **Respect the activity timetable; arrive on time and do not skip any session.**
- **Be active in discussions and contribute ideas and opinions.**
- **Respect the ideas and opinions of others, as well as all cultural differences.**
- **Personal travel during the project is not allowed.**
- **Follow local rules and the rules of the accommodation site.**
- **Keep the room tidy and respect others' sleep; avoid noisy discussions or music after 22:00.**
- **Clean the accommodation on the last day and leave everything in order.**
- **Do not consume alcohol during working hours of the program; avoid excessive drinking in general.**


