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PROJECT DESCRIPTION AND TOPIC:

Working with socially excluded youth or those at risk of social exclusion requires continuous improvement in qualifications and the introduction of new methods and tools. It is therefore particularly important for youth workers, educators and caregivers, pedagogues, psychologists, teachers, and other youth workers to refine their skills and acquire new competencies.

The project addresses the issue of **working with young people with social limitations** such as learning difficulties, economic problems, rural background, immigrant background, and single-parent families. All of these elements can exclude and hinder the transition to adult life.

These gaps and limitations are most often visible between the ages of 15 and 18. This meeting of young leaders working with youth will focus on **methods and tools** that will highlight the identified problems and help address these limitations and shortcomings.

From the beginning, we have had one main goal: to **inspire a unique approach**.

To demonstrate that working with young people with fewer opportunities can—and should—be diverse, flexible, and relationship-based, regardless of the problems and challenges they face daily.

We want to demonstrate that the **social deficiencies young people face can ultimately prove to be their strength**.

We want to encourage participants to experiment, explore their own methods, and be courageous in stepping outside the box.



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MAIN CHALLENGES AND ISSUES DURING THE WORKSHOPS

- The professional future of young people
- How to discover the talents of our youth?
- How to engage young people in volunteering and build their self-worth
- Do something different with youth, informal education – creative culinary, carpentry, and floristry workshops,
- Stop virtual reality and loneliness, engage real life and reality,
- Don't be passive, be entrepreneurial, help your future thanks your activity.

The aim was not to "teach everything," but to arouse curiosity, provide impulses for further development, and show that non-formal education really works when it is based on shared experience, dialogue, and observation.

2. Find tools and inspiration for youth work,
3. Use non-formal education.
