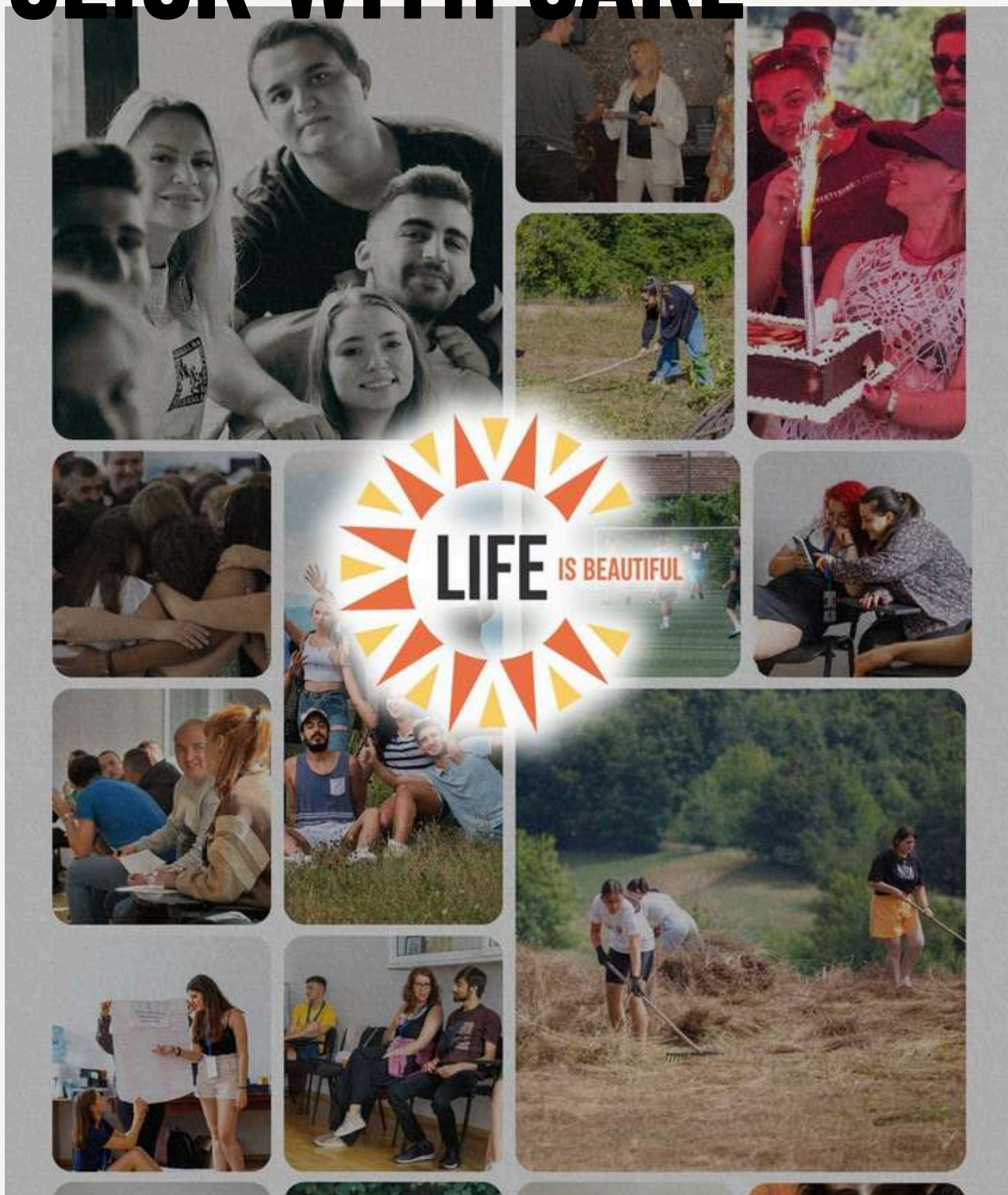

We are looking for **3 (18+) participants** from Romania, Greece, Türkiye, Hungary, Lithuania, and **4 (18+) participants** from Bulgaria and North Macedonia
(gender equality is recommended)

Travel cost

We encourage participants to choose green travel options for their journey (ex: car sharing, trains). The travel expenses will be reimbured according to the Erasmus+ distance band calculator.

Food and accomodation

We will provide 3 meals a day. For participants with special diets (vegetarian, vegan, halal, allergies etc), please inform us about your food preferences beforehand. If you have some extremely complicated diet or you would like to have some special ingredients that may not be available in Bulgaria, we would appreciate if you could take the food that you need with you.



PROJECT CONTEXT

"Truth or Trick? Click with Care" is an 8-day training course that responds to one of the biggest challenges of our time - disinformation in the digital environment. The project transforms participants from passive consumers of content into aware, critical-thinking and responsible digital citizens.

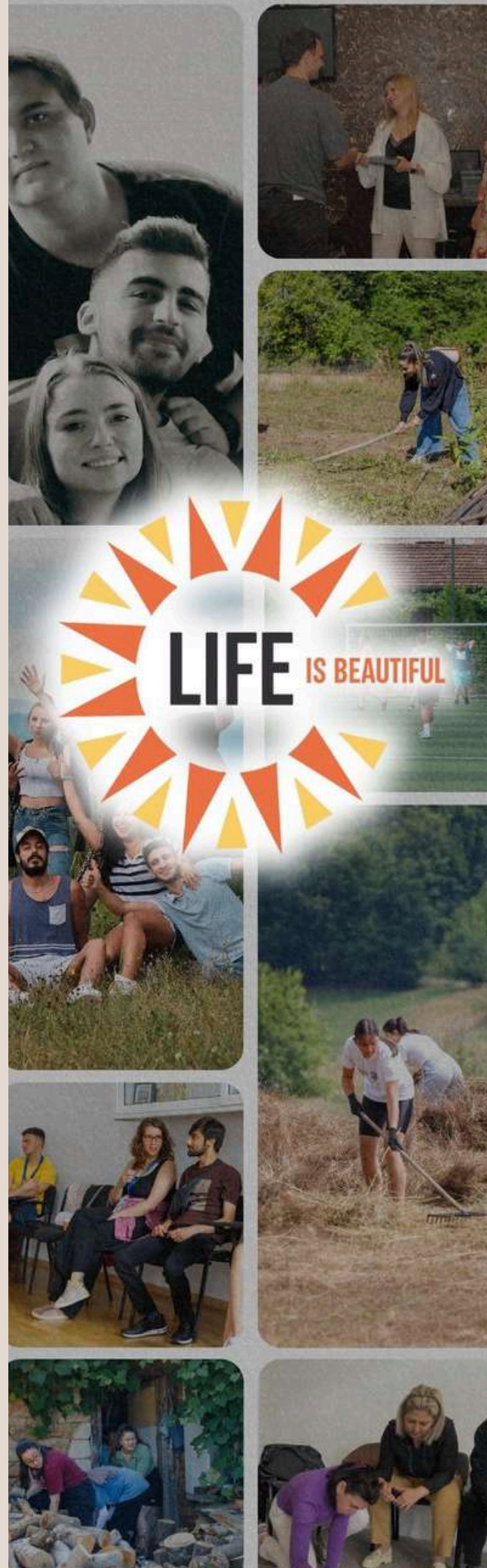
The activities are entirely practical and based on real examples from the online space. Participants will analyze news, publications, videos and social networks, learning to recognize fake news, manipulative techniques and hidden messages.

The training includes interactive sessions, case studies, group work and role-playing exercises, through which participants:

- develop skills in checking sources and facts
- understand how algorithms work and why “viral” is not always true
- explore the influence of emotions, fear and sensational headlines
- realize the responsibility they carry with every online sharing

A special focus is placed on the role of youth workers as knowledge multipliers – participants will develop ideas and tools that they can apply directly in their work with young people, schools and communities.

The course builds confidence, awareness and a proactive stance against disinformation by encouraging participants to think before they click and act before the fake news spreads.



ACCOMMODATION PLACE

ACCOMMODATION DETAILS

Participants will be accommodated in Hostel "Chayka" upon arrival. Each guest will complete a registration form and sign a compliance declaration with the internal rules of the facility. A short orientation meeting will take place with the organizing team and representatives of partner organizations to discuss important details. Participants will be assigned to two-bed rooms, each equipped with a private bathroom. Room assignments will be based on gender.



CHECK-IN PROCESS

Upon arrival, participants will receive:

- Room keys and accommodation details
- WiFi access information
- A short briefing on house rules and safety regulations

The goal is to ensure a smooth transition and comfortable stay for all participants.



DIETARY PREFERENCES AND RESTRICTIONS

If a participant has any dietary restrictions or preferences, they must inform the project coordinators in advance. Meals will be adjusted accordingly to ensure all participants have suitable options.

This arrangement ensures that all participants receive nutritious meals while respecting dietary requirements and cultural differences.



TIPS FOR A BETTER EXPERIENCE



01

EVERY PARTICIPANT NEEDS TO BRING:

Towels and suitable clothes for both inside and outside activities (please check the weather in advance), good mood, and traditional food and drinks for an intercultural evening.



02

EVERY GROUP NEEDS TO BRING:

One computer per group, icebreakers, and game ideas for workshops.



03

EVERY GROUP HAS TO PREPARE:

An interactive presentation about their country for the intercultural evening, small souvenirs or symbols representing their country, and a short cultural performance or activity.



04

SMALL SOUVENIRS OR SYMBOLS REPRESENTING YOUR COUNTRY

Bring small items like postcards, key chains, or traditional handicrafts to share with others. This will make the intercultural evening more engaging and memorable.



05

PREPARE A SHORT CULTURAL PERFORMANCE OR ACTIVITY

Whether it's a traditional dance, a song, a short quiz, or a fun fact session, an interactive element will make the experience more enjoyable and engaging for all participants.



MORE ABOUT MADAN



Madan is a city in southern Bulgaria, located in the heart of the Rhodopes. It is located in the Smolyan region and is a medium-sized city in the region. The city is the administrative center of the Madan municipality, with a population of 15,500 people, including the city of Madan and 44 villages.

Name The name of the city comes from the old Arabic-Turkish word *maden*, which in translation means "mineral, ore, mine", preserved in older maps as *Maden köy* - "ore village". According to another theory, the name "madan" refers to a primitive mechanical device for processing and crushing the ore - the so-called "self-made".

Museums In Madan, in 1984, the Crystal Hall "Rhodope Crystal" was opened, which is a collection of mineral crystal specimens mined from the Company's mines since its inception. It houses 581 exhibits.
