The essence of the project:

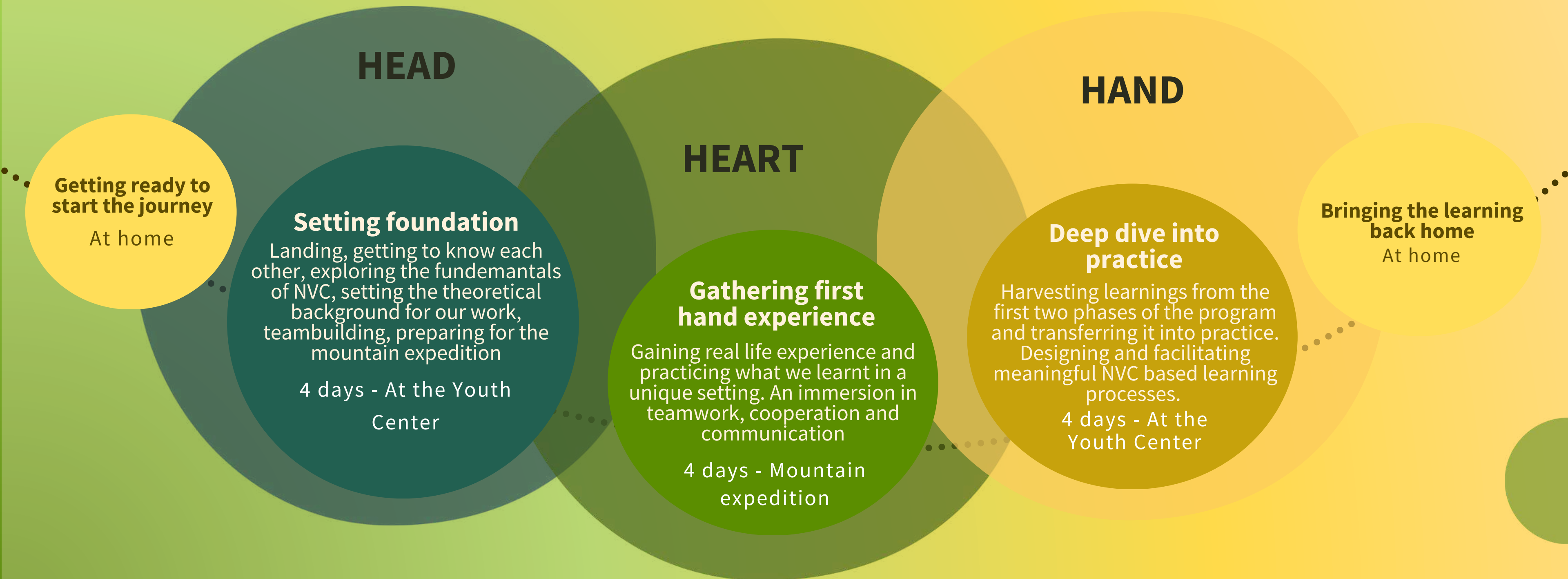
To strengthen youth workers' communication, empathy, and emotional resilience by integrating NonViolent Communication (NVC) with Outdoor Experiential Education, enabling them to build more compassionate, effective, and inclusive youth environments.

You will be invited to...

- Develop core NVC competences (observation – feelings – needs – requests) for real youth work contexts
- Experience NVC as a practical tool for cooperation, conflict transformation, and group management
- Listen beyond words using the 4 Levels of listening, empathy models and perspective-taking
- Strengthen emotional resilience and self-empathy through both theory and lived experience
- Develop skills for supporting youth in creating authentic, assertive, and compassionate communication styles

building, and areas for group meetings/training. The youth center has a small lake and a ropes course, a big courtyard. The participants will be accommodated in 3 to 5 bedded rooms, with common bathroom.

Target group



We expect 2-3 participants from each partner organization:

- youth workers, trainers, educators, coaches and volunteers aged 21+
- good communication skills in English
- interested in spending time outdoors in nature and willing to develop authentic, assertive communication skills
- ready to spend 4 days in nature without digital technology

Travel reimbursement



- You will be reimbursed the exact amount of your travel expenses (from your home town to the venue of the event) inside the limit assigned to your country if you provide us with ALL your original travel tickets and
- invoices. Taxi and first class tickets are (unfortunately) not covered.
- Reimbursement will be done by bank transfer in Euro to the sending organizations and sent further by them to the participants.

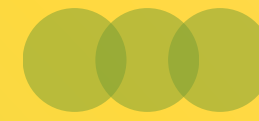


Please keep in mind that in Romania public transport is not so good as in the other EU countries, so please use the suggested routes!

Packing list



When packing for OUTWARD BOUND it is good to remember that you will be living an active lifestyle. Focus on function, not fashion! We will spend most of our time outside, so please **be prepared for a wide range of weather conditions** (hot during the day, chilly at night, possibly rainy).

The following list should help you not to forget anything important!

- waterproof hiking boots
- sport shoes
- slippers or any kind of indoor shoes
- big backpack (50l) for the expedition and a small backpack (20l) for day hikes
- min. 1.5 liter water bottle (PET bottle)
- sunglasses, sunscreen & hat
- enough clothes for the 12 days long program taking into consideration the layers system
- synthetic clothes, that can dry fast
- windproof layer
- raincoat / waterproof jacket
- toiletry, slippers, towels for the shower
- pajamas
- headlamp or torch
- personal mug
- personal medication (if needed)
- ID and European Health Insurance Card

Please check the weather forecast before packing and take into consideration, that in the mountains will be 5-10 degrees less than in the city of Sovata. OBR can provide outdoor equipment like: 45 l backpack, raincoat (poncho), sleeping bag, camping mattress, gaiters, hiking sticks, outdoor jacket, outdoor cutlery. Keep it in your mind these pieces of equipment were used by many other participants. If you consider that your own equipment is better than ours you can bring it.

Please do NOT bring items that are highly valuable or irreplaceable. It is best to bring only necessary and easily replaceable possessions. Please do not bring alcohol or illegal drugs of any kind. Please do not use sensitive electronic devices during the program - we can store these items in a safe place during the activities if you wish.

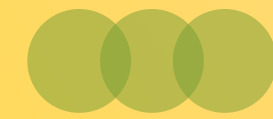
Selection is on-going by the partner organisations so do not hesitate too long to send your application!
