# Before the arrival

Before arrival, please read the infopack carefully, confirm your participation with your sending organisation, and complete all required participant forms. Join the preparatory meeting, check the practical and safety information, and prepare any materials needed for your national workshop contribution. Please also arrange your travel, keep your tickets and documents, make sure you have valid health insurance or EHIC, and join the common communication group before departure.

# After the departure

After the project, participants are expected to stay involved by completing the final evaluation, contributing to their Youthpass, and taking part in follow-up activities. Each participant should share the project results in their organisation or local community, for example through a workshop, presentation, post, video, or other dissemination activity. Participants will also stay connected through the alumni or online group and may be invited to join follow-up meetings or future cooperation activities.

# Venue, accommodation and food

Project will take place in Ubytovanie One, Dolný Ohaj, Slovakia. Participants will share rooms of same gender (4/3/2 participants per room). Accommodation provides one towel, training/dining room, swimming pool and sauna. We will provide you board games, volleyball and football ball.

We provide 3 meals per day - breakfast, lunch (sometimes can be packed lunch e.g. for a hike), dinner and 2x coffee-breaks.

The food will be cooked by accommodation. If you have any diet or allergy please write it in the application form. The tap water is drinkable.

Please keep in mind that erasmus project is not a vacation or stay in 5\* hotel.
