Background

Are you passionate about working with young people and want to grow as a facilitator? Do you want to explore and develop your own facilitation style to empower youth through creative, inclusive methods?

ELIX invites **youth workers, teachers, trainers, educators, facilitators, administrators of education programmes** to apply for FaciliForward: Skills for Youth Empowerment, aiming at developing facilitation skills to foster inclusion, creativity, and meaningful participation in youth work. The programme focuses to build participants' confidence, help them reflect on their own challenges, and develop a unique facilitation style. Through non-formal education, hands-on practice, and peer exchange, participants will strengthen their capacity to engage young people effectively.

Objectives

- Develop a better understanding of what facilitation is and the key competences required to become a youth facilitator
- Offer space for participants to reflect on their personal challenges and uncertainties related to facilitation
- Support participants in building their own facilitation style and creative toolkit, adaptable to various youth work contexts
- Enable participants to apply and evaluate their facilitation style and tools in their organizations after the training

- Youth workers, teachers, educators, facilitators, administrators of education programmes, active volunteers in youth organizations motivated to develop facilitation skills and apply them in local or international youth work
- Aged 18+ and comfortable working in English
- Committed to taking part in the entire training course and to implementing a follow-up activity afterward
