It also provides support and assistance to the local youth council. 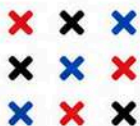
## What is the project about?

During the training, we will introduce, analyse, and more importantly, PLAY games and playful activities that can be widely applied by anyone who works with children, runs camps, organises school activities, or even leads a youth exchange, all while using non-formal methods.

Throughout the week, we will cover everything from simple energisers to complex team-based challenges. You'll learn various methods for dividing participants into teams in a playful way, as well as techniques for evaluating sessions and discussing what was learned. The training will also include support on how participants can adapt the methods they've learned to their daily work.

## Participants

This training course will involve youth workers, trainers, teachers, and everyone who works with communities. Each country may send two participants who are at least 18 years old. A basic knowledge of English is essential for all of you.

snacks and fruits. Here, your contribution is also needed:  
bring some snacks.

We kindly ask all of you to provide your dietary restrictions as  
specifically as possible so we can be prepared. If you don't  
do that, we won't be able to address it.

### Intercultural Evenings & Intercultural Coffee Breaks

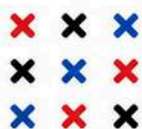
Groups will be asked to present their own countries at one of the intercultural evenings. Countries will have a maximum of 20 minutes and can choose how they wish to present their countries. You will have to present snacks and sweets during the coffee breaks. Please bear that in mind!

## PARTICIPANTS' FORM

### Packing list:

- Typical candies, sweets, biscuits, savoury, beverages for the coffee breaks and the intercultural evening;
  - Small backpack for little excursions;
- Shoes that are good for going outside: we will have a few outdoor programs.;
- Practical clothes for different kinds of weather: chilly, rainy;
  - Clothes, shoes that you don't mind getting dirty!
- Raincoat or umbrella in case of rain during the outdoor elements of the program;
- Personal things: hygiene-related, medicines you usually take or other things you need;
  - Cash for your personal purchases(Forint).

In Hungary, the currency is the Forint (HUF)  
and not the Euro!!!



## Financial Aspects and Invoicing

When looking for options to travel to Hungary, make sure you choose the most economical way. Please consider the cheapest flights possible! You must buy an economy-class flight ticket or a second-class train ticket to get reimbursed. When planning your trip, please consider the travel times. Don't forget to consult with us about the travel and only buy tickets after our confirmation.

You can add extra days to your travel at your own cost, a maximum of 2 days (before, after, or combined with the dates of the youth exchange). Please keep in mind that you have to finance your accommodation and food during your extra days since they are not included in the project.

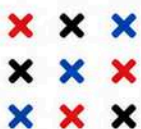
When you have found a suitable way of travel, and you are about to book your tickets, you must ask for an invoice which states the name (attention: full name is required) and address of our organisation:



Please make sure you ask for an invoice; otherwise, we will NOT be able to reimburse you for your expenses. Please let us know if you can't request an invoice:

- Your name, the dates of your travel and the ticket's price must be clearly written on your ticket;
- In case of travelling by train, the ticket must show your name and the dates of your travel too;
- You MUST keep your boarding passes and tickets. After the event, you will be kindly asked to send them back to us. In case you arrive by train, you will need to send us your original tickets.

Please book your ticket on your or your organisation's expense. We plan to reimburse your travel costs after the youth exchange via bank transfer upon showing all proof of documents.





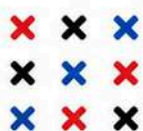
Once we have received all your travel details to Hungary, we will inform you with more information on how to arrive at the venue (which means a transfer provided by us). Please keep in mind that your local travel in Hungary will cost around 40-45 Euros (this applies to those travelling through Budapest), which is also included in your total travel limit!

Travel reimbursement can only be completed if participants fully understand and follow the rules that the group will create on the first day. Full participation is required!
