About NextGen Lab

NextGen Lab is a 9-day **Youth Exchange** that brings together young people from different countries to learn, create and grow through non-formal education, organized by National Youth Foundation (FNT) and Co-funded by European Union through ERASMUS+ program.

Participants Profile

We are looking for young people aged **18–30 years old** who are interested in learning, intercultural exchange, and active participation.

Each **partner organization is invited to send 4 participants and 1 group leader**.

The group leader must be 18 years old or older. We strongly recommend selecting someone with experience in youth work, intercultural environments, international mobility, and good English communication skills, as they will support the group throughout the project.

Participants will explore topics such as:

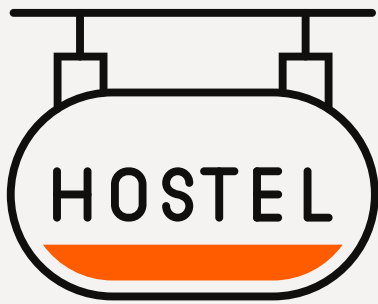

Popcorn Hostel

Popcorn Hostel is located approximately 10 minutes from Gara de Nord (Bucharest North Railway Station), offering easy access to public transportation and connections to the airport.

We encourage participants to use public transportation whenever possible, especially those arriving by plane, as it is an affordable, convenient and environmentally friendly way to travel around the city.



Airport Accommodation

Recommended transport: Train

- Route: Henri Coandă International Airport (OTP) → Bucharest North Railway Station (Gara de Nord)
- Travel time: approximately 20–30 minutes
- Train availability: Day and night
- From Gara de Nord to Popcorn Hostel: approximately 10 minutes on foot
- Ticket price: 6.50 RON (approximately €1.30)
- Payment: Tickets can be purchased directly in the train by card.

We encourage participants to use public transportation whenever possible, as it is a convenient, affordable and environmentally friendly option.

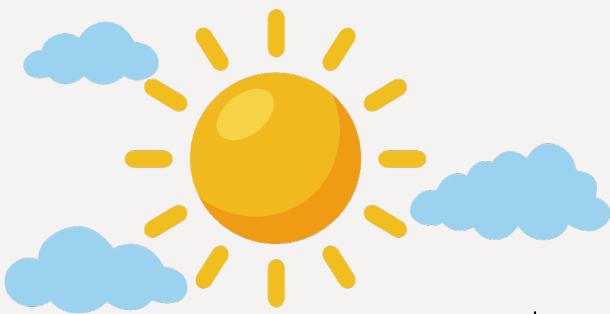


Good to Know

- Free Wi-Fi is available at the accommodation and activity venue.
- Card payments are widely accepted in Romania.
- The local currency is Romanian Leu (RON).
- Emergency number in Romania: 112.
- Most supermarkets and pharmacies are within walking distance from the accommodation.

Weather

August in Bucharest is usually warm and sunny, with temperatures between 28–35°C. We recommend bringing light summer clothes, sunglasses, sunscreen, and a reusable water bottle.



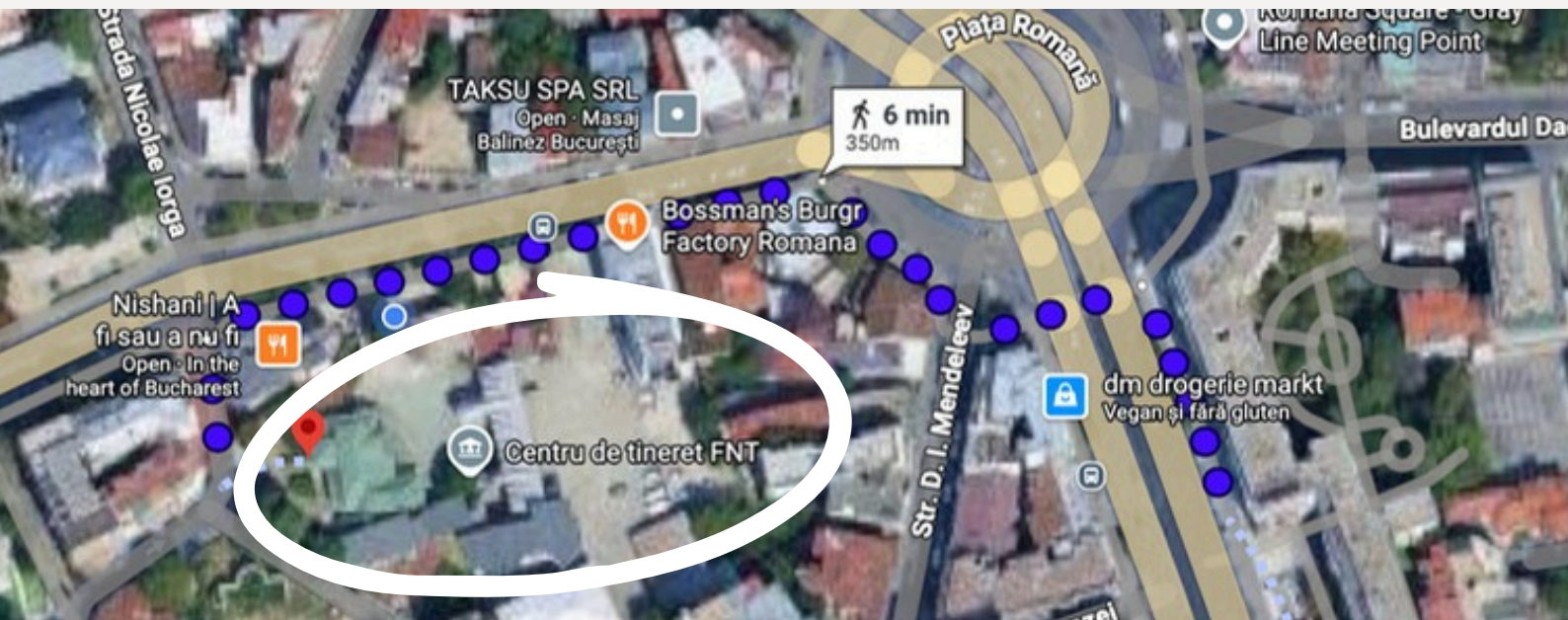
Activities Venue

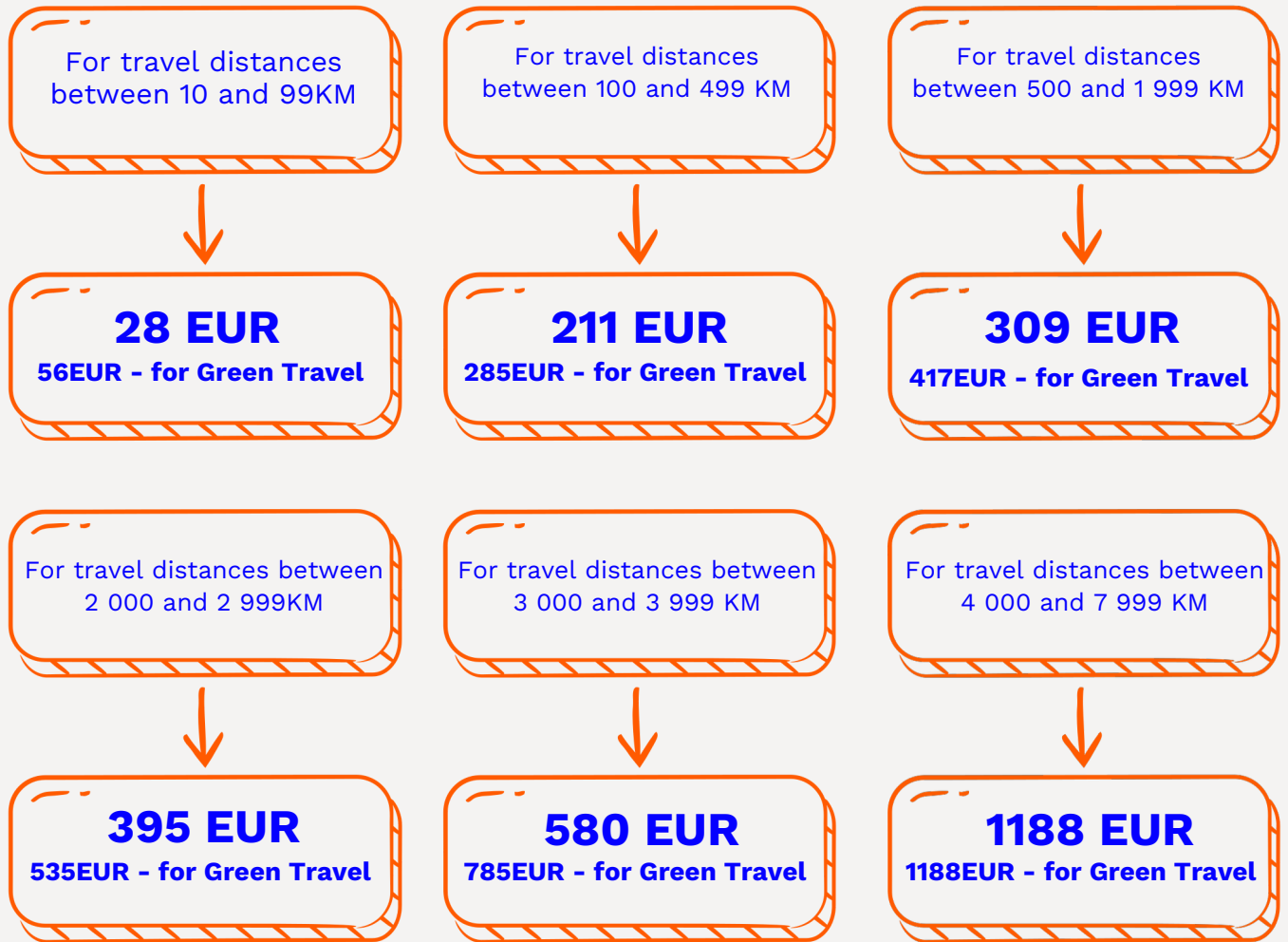


The Youth by FNT

Travel reimbursement

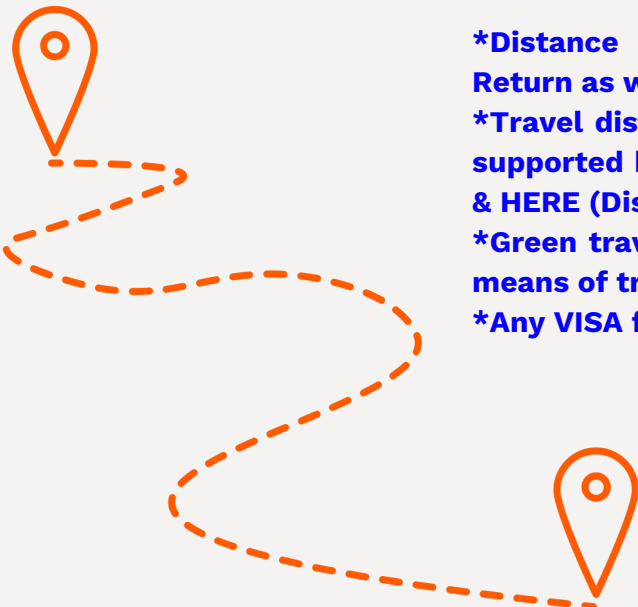


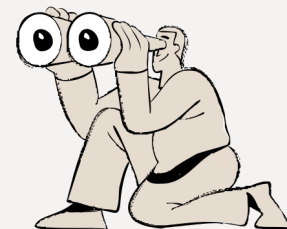
***Distance is calculated from your place of origin to Bucharest. Return as well.**
