





2

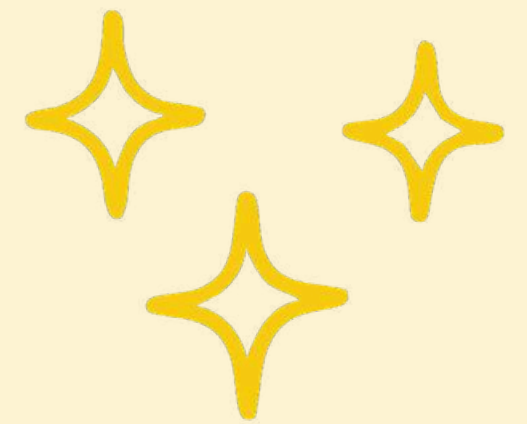
To introduce the participants to the theatre of the oppressed methodologies and give them the opportunity to explore it themselves.

PARTICIPANTS

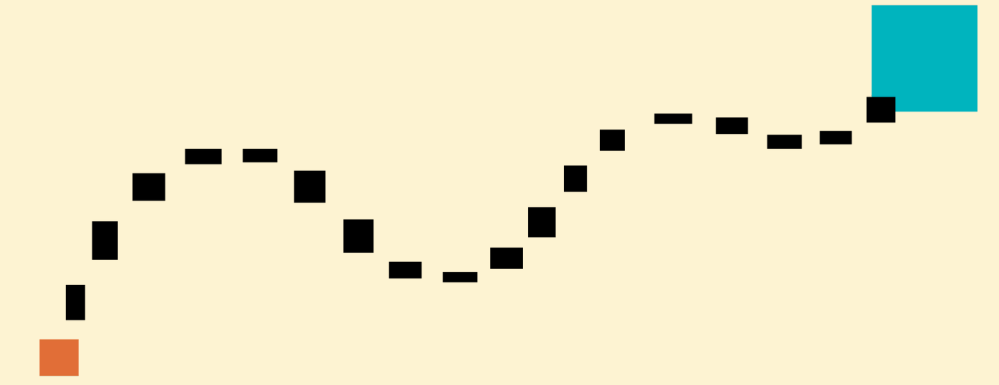
Europe, people living in motivated to engage in intercultural dialogue, non-formal learning, theatre of the oppressed methodology and collective experiences.

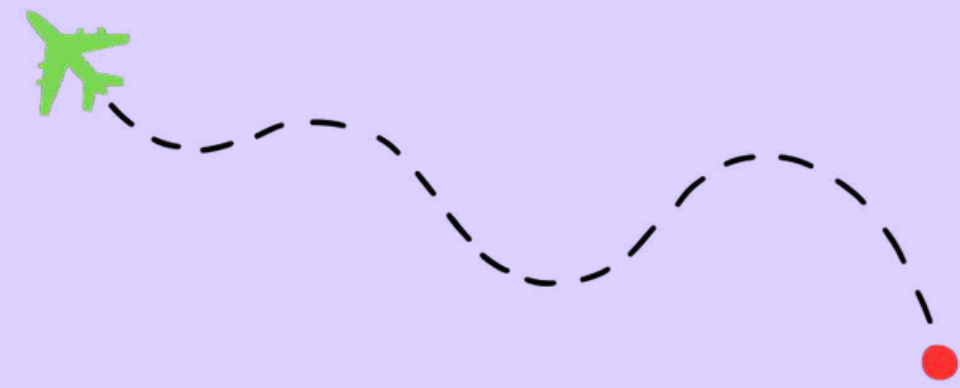
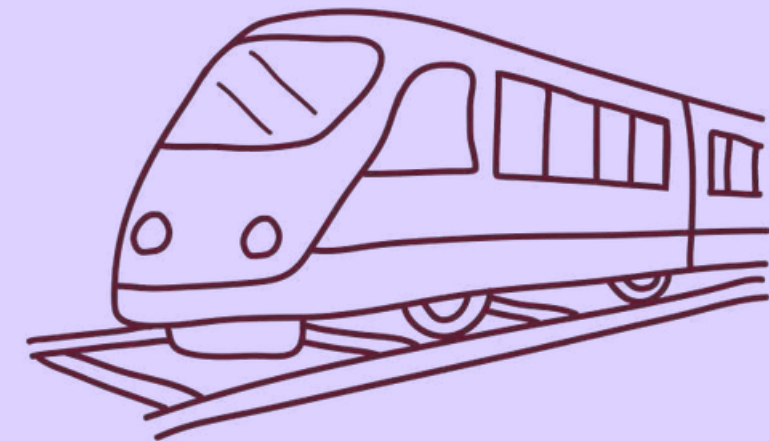

Venue



We will stay at **Fabric Hostel**

ADDRESS: Via Francesco Bellucci Sessa, 22 – Portici (Naples)

The hostel is located in the city center of Portici (market area) and is less than a 10-minute walk from the Granatello harbor.

The hostel provides Wi-Fi in the common areas and a shared kitchen equipped with a fridge. Check-in is scheduled for 15:00.

Breakfast will be served in the hostel's restaurant area.

Both the Circumvesuviana station "Portici Via Libertà" and the Portici–Ercolano train station (Ferrovie dello Stato) are about a 10-minute walk from the hostel.



Portici



Portici is a vibrant seaside town in the Metropolitan City of Naples, known for being the most densely populated municipality in Italy, with around 12,000 inhabitants per square kilometer. Despite its small size, it offers a unique mix of history, nature, and local life.

Nestled on the western slopes of Mount Vesuvius and overlooking the beautiful Gulf of Naples. One of the most charming areas of the city is Granatello, a small and picturesque harbor where you can relax by the sea. Its name comes from the many pomegranate trees that once filled the area in the 18th century, stretching from the Royal Palace to a nearby convent.

A highlight of Portici is the Royal Palace, a historic and elegant residence that today hosts one of the most important Faculties of Agriculture in Southern Italy. Inside, you can also find a beautiful Botanical Garden, a peaceful and inspiring place where rare plants and flowers from all over the world are preserved.

Portici is also part of the **Miglio d'Oro (Golden Mile)**, a stretch famous for its 16th-century villas.

The town is home to the National Railway Museum, Museo di Pietrarsa, and the site of the first railway station in Italy (Naples–Portici, 1839), which was the second in Europe after Liverpool–Manchester (1823).

Distances from Portici:

- 12 minutes by train to Naples
- 15 minutes on foot to the archaeological site of Herculaneum and the MAV – Virtual Archaeological Museum
- 20 minutes by train to the archaeological site of Pompeii
- 45 minutes by train to the Sorrento and Amalfi coasts



How to reach the Venue

■ HOW TO REACH PORTICI FROM NAPOLI CAPODICHINO AIRPORT

Step 1 - From Naples Airport to Napoli Centrale (Main Railway Station)

The easiest way is to take the ALIBUS airport shuttle, which departs every 20 minutes from outside the airport terminal and arrives at Napoli Piazza Garibaldi (Napoli Centrale railway station).

The service operates from 06:30 to 22:05 and the ticket costs € 6.

Step 2 - by Circumvesuviana train

1. From **Napoli Centrale**, go to the **Circumvesuviana station at Piazza Garibaldi** (inside or right next to the main station).
2. Take a train heading towards **Torre del Greco** or **Poggiomarino**.
3. Get off at **Portici Via Libertà** station.

Details:

- Trains run approximately every 20 minutes
- Operating hours: 07:00 – 21:00
- Ticket price: €1.60
- Travel time: around 15–20 minutes

How to reach the Venue

■ HOW TO REACH PORTICI FROM ROME FIUMICINO AIRPORT

Step 1 - Fiumicino Airport to Rome Termini Station

- Take the Leonardo Express train from Fiumicino Airport (FCO) to Roma Termini (the main train station in Rome).
- Duration: ~32 minutes
- Runs every 15–30 minutes
- Ticket: €14

Step 2 – Rome Termini to Naples Centrale

- From Roma Termini, take a high-speed train (Frecciarossa, Italo, or Frecciargento) to Napoli Centrale.
- Duration: 1 hour 10–2 hours depending on the train
- Ticket: €20–€50 (prices vary by train type and booking time)

Step 3 – Napoli Centrale to Portici

- Follow the Circumvesuviana directions:
 - a.From Napoli Centrale, go to the Circumvesuviana station at Piazza Garibaldi.
 - b.Take a train towards Torre del Greco or Poggiomarino.
 - c.Get off at Portici Via Libertà.
- Duration: ~15–20 minutes
- Ticket: €1.60
- Trains run every ~20 minutes

 - The organization's core mission is to foster social inclusion by ensuring equal access to opportunities and resources for young people aged 14 to 30, with a particular focus on those with fewer opportunities, including young people with migrant backgrounds, minors in reception systems, and LGBTQI+ youth.
 - Since 2011, Arciragazzi has developed a strong and long-term partnership with Cooperativa Sociale Shannara, an organization working with at-risk minors, unaccompanied foreign minors, and young women who are victims of trafficking. This collaboration has strengthened the organization's capacity to address complex social issues and to empower young people to take an active role in society as agents of positive change.
- Through its extensive experience in project design and implementation, Arciragazzi has been actively involved
- in international and Euro-Mediterranean cooperation initiatives focusing on migration and social inclusion. The organization has implemented a wide range of activities, including training courses, youth exchanges, study visits, and projects under the European Solidarity Corps (ESC), promoting non-formal education and intercultural dialogue.
- Finally, Arciragazzi Portici is a member of the European Network Against Racism (ENAR), reinforcing its
- commitment to combating discrimination and promoting equality.
