**Each partner should select 1-2 staff members or youth workers, aged 20+, with experience in the Erasmus+ programme and in youth work. Erasmus students and ESC volunteers at the time of mobility are not eligible. Participants should be citizens of sending countries or legal residents for at least until 31 August 2027. Where there are 2 participants from one country, we can accept a maximum of one resident (non-citizen).**

### **Description of the project:**

**"Something here is missing"** is a training course that will take place in Buzau, Romania, between 1 and 10 August 2026, with 30 participants and 4 experts



### **Aim of the project:**

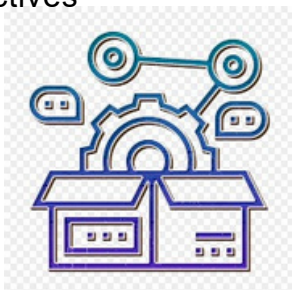
The aim of the project is to provide youth workers with competencies and tools for a better valorisation of the results of Erasmus + mobilities

## Objectives



### Objectives:

1. To develop new tools and competences for youth workers to increase the valorisation of results during the follow-up phase of projects
2. To increase the civic engagement of participants after the mobilities in the local sending communities
3. To raise awareness of the role of youth workers and youth associations in the promotion of European democratic values and Erasmus + priorities and objectives
4. To strengthen the role of youth workers in expanding European cooperation through new common projects to promote European democratic values and Erasmus + priorities and objectives



**The methodology** is based on non-formal education methods including presentations, world café, theater, debate, simulations, video creation etc. The project activities will be preparation, introduction, getting to know each other, workshops in plenary and teams, outdoor activities, intercultural evenings, visits, reflection and evaluation according to agenda.

Final products expected: a set of tools and methods, and a guide book let to increase valorisation of results after mobilities in the sending organisation

and in local communities



**Accommodation:** Hotel Sport B90 Buzau – in rooms with 2 or 3 beds with private bathroom and shower. **There are no laundry or ironing services in the hotel.**

**Food** will be served at the restaurant of the hotel, and there will be 3 meals every day and coffee breaks.

Please send us your special needs concerning food: no pork, no meat, vegetarian or any allergies.



**Activities:** will be in the same place in different rooms. Some of the activities will be outdoors.

**Facilities and visits:** the pension is 10 minutes walking from the city centre and 15 minutes from the shopping area where you can find almost everything: shops, pharmacy, banks, restaurants, etc.

**We are working to plan a visit to the surroundings of the UNESCO heritage “Buzau Geopark”.**



**The weather** is quite hot in the summer. Average temperature in August is around 25-30 degrees during the day and 15-20 degrees during the night, but can be colder, warmer or raining. So be prepared for everything. We'll keep you updated with the weather forecast.



**IMPORTANT!!! Pay attention to basic rules and safety measures:**

- You'll living an intercultural environment, so accept all cultures and be tolerant
- NO DRUGS ALLOWED!! Alcohol only after activities in the evening and consumed with responsibility!! Smoking of any kind (traditional, vapes, tobacco heating devices etc.) is allowed only outside and in designated places.
- You have to attend and be involved in ALL ACTIVITIES during the training and also in the DISSEMINATION PHASE!!

Other rules and safety measures will be fixed in first day, so if you have proposals, feel free to express them!!



**Transport:** For those arriving in Bucharest Otopeni, there is a **TRAIN** directly to **GARA DE NORD** every 30 minutes that takes 20 minutes and costs 7.5 lei. In the train station **GARA DE NORD**, you can easily find the ticket office and buy your tickets to BUZAU. You can pay by card at the train station, but there is also a machine for tickets. You can book tickets online on [www.cfrcalatori.ro](http://www.cfrcalatori.ro) as well. The trip is around 2 hours.

As you'll get on the train in Bucharest, we'll ask you to send us a WhatsApp message with the time of arrival. Until the time of your arrival, we will make a WhatsApp group with the participants, so you will be able to use it as a means of communication.

From Buzau train station to the hotel, there are buses. Alternatively, you can take a BOLT or taxi that costs around 2-3 euros, but you need to know that those expenses are not reimbursable.

Another option is to take **MINIBUS** form airport directly to Buzau for 2 hours trip –you can find on google different companies and buy tickets. If you want to, we can book for you – the cost of a ticket is 16 euros

**Make sure to arrive in train station in Bucharest before 22.30h –after that hour there is no public transport until early in the morning.**

**For the way back, from Buzau, there are minibuses to the airport or trains to Bucharest.**

## OBLIGATORY!!

What should you prepare:

- Research about tools and methods used by your organisation for the dissemination of the final results of Erasmus+ mobilities
- Be prepared to propose games, energisers, and activities for free time or for our workshops
- Some laptops will be necessary for working and editing texts/photos/videos
- As we want to use as less plastic as possible please bring with you your own bottle/recipient for water; you will need to stay hydrated, as the weather is very hot at that time of the year



- **for intercultural evening you are asked to bring some traditional food and drinks and to be ready to teach us a song or a dance.**



**ATTENTION!!** There is no possibility to use kitchen for cooking (because of regulations about safety and hygiene) so bring dry things ...you can prepare short and easy meals that can be done without oven like salads etc...if you need some ingredients like vegetables, oil, salt, regular spices, bread etc. there is a LIDL very close to hotel, also some drinks from some of your countries can be found around



## REIMBURSEMENT:

In order to get the travel costs back, we need to get from you, if possible, **PRINTED ON PAPER and ARRANGED IN ORDER OF TRAVELLING PHASES FROM DEPARTURE TO DESTINATION.**

All **BUS/TRAIN/FERRY** tickets and invoices in original.

Tickets should have a date, itinerary, and cost. If there is no name on it, write it on the back of the document

For **FLIGHTS**: electronic ticket with name, dates, itinerary, costs **AND INVOICE** if some of previous item is not on the ticket. Luggage or check-in fees added at the airport are not eligible- do them before

**BOARDING PASSES** are **mandatory** – keep them as a proof of the fact that you travelled in Romania. If you did mobile check-in, you can send us the print screen with it -save them after check-in!

Take only **APEX** flights (no business class) and only 2nd class trains.

- TAXI/BOLT/UBER or similar costs are not eligible unless in exceptional situations
- Be sure to have the price and data on bus and train tickets, as well as on airplane tickets. If not, ask for receipts or invoices.
- If you travel by CAR, contact us to tell you the rules and documents needed.
- Insurances are in charge of every participant, and costs **are not eligible** from the project budget. Nonetheless, we highly recommend having travel insurance. The public health system is free in case of emergencies, but sometimes the private ones work better/faster. Let's hope that it will be a futile precaution, but it's good to be prepared for any kind of situation.



- If your participants plan to use **GREEN TRAVEL** (bus, train, carpooling) write us for details as they can have more benefits

**The reimbursement will be in accordance with the distance calculator for the maximum amounts approved in the application and will be made after the project, when we'll receive all ORIGINAL documents. The amounts for reimbursement will be based on REAL COSTS of the tickets/invoice presented. There will be one transfer for every country on account of the sending organisation.**

Maximum approved travel costs are based on distance from your sending organisation venue to Buzau, based on the distance calculator link [Distance Calculator - Erasmus+ \(europa.eu\)](https://europa.eu/distance-calculator)



- 100 – 499 km: 211 euros/285 green travel
- 500 – 1999 km: 309 euros/ 417 green travel
- 2000 – 2999 km: 395 euros/535 green travel
- 3000 – 3999 km: 580 euros/ 785 green travel
- +4000 km – 1188 eur

Participants can spend 2-3 days before or after the project in Romania, but no costs of accommodation, food, local transport or other expenses will be reimbursed for days outside the project.

Currency : 1 euro = 5.20 lei (RON ).  
There are banks and ATMs in the airport, in the Bucharest train station, in Buzau

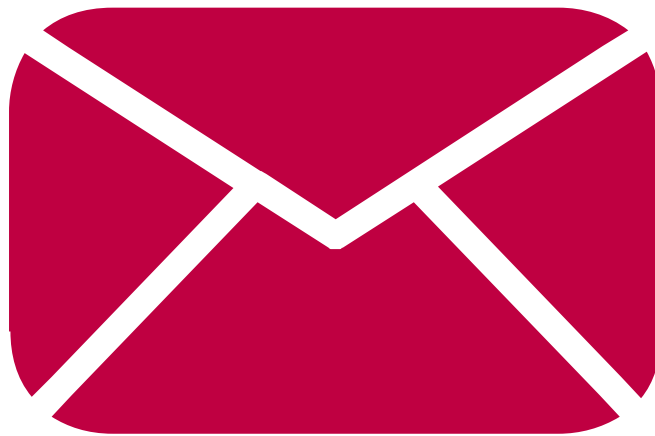
