Venue - Szaporcai Cifraház in Szaporca village, Hungary

Szaporca is a small village with approximately 180 habitants in South Hungary, part of the Ormánság geographical region.

The village has original traditional appearance surrounded by natural environment: forests and fields, Drava river, small lakes, Fekete Víz river, National Park, bike path and built heritage.

Szaporcai Cifraház, the center of Vidéken Jó! Foundation is the location of the project. Szaporcai Cifraház is a community center for arts, exhibitions, traditions, music, professions and food. In front of the Szaporcai Cifraház you can find the “Pipitér” chicken farm which is and educational farm.



Main goals

- Climate change – changing habits, behaviours, and gaining insight into grassroots initiatives
- Trees role in the climate change
- Understand the the cause-and-effect relationship of the actions
- Focusing on self and rural activities, restarting your life in sustainable way.
- Get closer to rural and sustainable life through practical activities
- Green skills, sustainability, climate change

Activities

- Being the part of a very small village community for a week
- All the activities will be outdoor in the nature (we use natural air condition)
- Handcraft workshops – learning different useful methods
- Learn practical skills to sustainable life and farming
- Carving a cutlery from wood
- Design fence from wood
- LandArt and focusing on sustainable forest management
- Bike trip in the microregion
- Meet new people
- Present your culture for the participants

Food

Daily 3 main menu (breakfast, lunch, dinner) and snacks, fruits, drinks during the day will be provided by Vidéken Jó! Alapítvány. The mostly traditional menu will be consistent with the dietary habits of participants (vegetarians, vegans, gluten free, lactose free...). If available, ingredients will come from local producers supporting local farmers.

The menu contain traditional dishes.

We use reusable plastic cups and plates for the meals. For daily drink don't forget to bring and use your own water bottle!



Accommodation

Participants and group leaders will be accommodated at local guesthouses with rooms with 4-5 beds in Tésenfa and Szaporca. Some beds are double. All guesthouses are max 1,5 km by walk from the project venue (Szaporcai Cifraház). There are 1 toilet and shower for around 5-6 persons. The laundry will be available at one guesthouse, you will give the owner your laundry and you will get it back dry.

Optional for 3-4 participants to sleep in tent.

Bring your towel, bathroom slippers, shower gel, shampoo, and other personal needs (toothbrush, etc)!

You will get one bedclothes for the whole project, please take care of it, the owners can't change them.

Cleaning of the accommodation during the project will be the participants' tasks. Smoking, loud music, alcohol is not allowed in the guesthouses!

Travel information

ARRIVAL DAY: 19 August 2026. afternoon if possible until 14.00 to Budapest, then we will help to organize your trip to Szaporca (approx. 4 hours by train and rented minibus)

DEPARTURE DAY: 28 August 2026. from Szaporca early morning. It takes again approx. 4 hours to get to Budapest.

If you come by bus, train or plane you might arrive to Budapest. From Budapest Keleti Train Station you can travel by train to Pécs (Vidéken Jó! Alapítvány will buy your train tickets!) From Pécs we will organize minibus for the team. Bear in mind, the journey from Budapest to Szaporca takes approx. 4 hours.

You can arrive by your own car, in this case please contact us and try to take some more participants with you. (Green travel)

In any case we are here to help to manage your travel!

You can arrive 1-2 days earlier or leave later all, together you can spend maximum 2 days in Hungary and your travel cost between your home and the project venue will be covered by the project. All other costs must be covered by you!

Travel Reimbursement – calculated with the Erasmus+ distance calculator

Hungary – Depends from how far you are coming - 56-285 euro

Croatia – max. 211 euro / person GREENTRAVEL:285euro/person - if possible please use green travel!!

Romania – max. 309 euro / person GREENTRAVEL:417euro/person – if possible please use green travel!!

Lithuania - max. 309 euro / person GREEN TRAVEL: 417 euro/person

Spain – max. 395 euro / person

In order to be eligible for reimbursement you need to send us (NOT PRINT SCREEN, BUT ORIGINAL EMAIL about your ITINERARY):

- tickets without its price on it can't be reimbursed (metro/bus tickets are not reimbursable without an invoice written for your name)
- for the flight ticket the original itinerary and boarding pass needed.

Travel reimbursements will be reimbursed latest until 15 December 2026, once (and if)

- participants take part in full duration of the programme, fill out the evaluation forms after the project, present all the traveling documents

Travel cost will be reimbursed for 1 person (groupleader) or the partnerorganisation / national group. We kindly ask to share it among the attached schedule with your team member.
