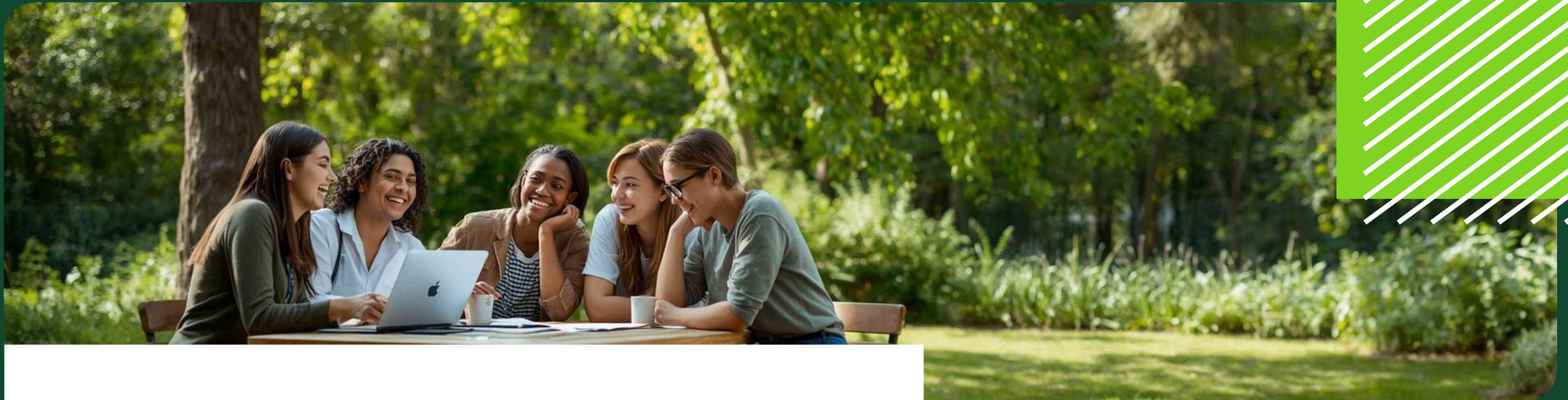

Exchange knowledge and good practices on green transition among young people from Lithuania, Bulgaria, Cyprus, Spain, and Romania.

O2: Video Podcast Series

Develop a video podcast series showcasing leading EU cities' green initiatives and innovative environmental solutions from across Europe.

O3 & O4: Community & Competences

Raise awareness in local communities of partner countries (O3) and develop green and civic competences through interactive activities and challenges (O4).

Pack smart for your trip to Predeal, Romania! Here's everything you need to prepare for a full week of activities, mountain weather, and cultural exchange.

Attitude & Documents

Bring a positive attitude, willingness to cooperate, your passport/ID, medication, and your European Health Insurance Card or relevant medical documents.

Tech & Work Materials

Bring a laptop or tablet to prepare and present materials during the video podcast creation workshops and group activities throughout the exchange.

Clothing & Footwear

Pack wind and waterproof outerwear, sturdy mountain boots, and lighter clothes for indoor sessions. Predeal is a mountain resort – expect varied weather in November.

Cultural Night Items

Prepare something special from your country for Cultural Night – traditional food, drinks, music, small gifts, or decorations to share your culture with the group.

Costs & Funding

Erasmus+ Funded

This project is fully funded by the Erasmus+ Programme of the European Commission. No participation fee is required.

Meals & Accommodation

100% of meals and accommodation costs are covered for all participants throughout the entire exchange.

Activity Costs

100% of all activity costs are covered. Transport is reimbursed within the Erasmus+ travel budget limits by your sending organization.

Reimbursed by partner organizations upon submission of receipts.

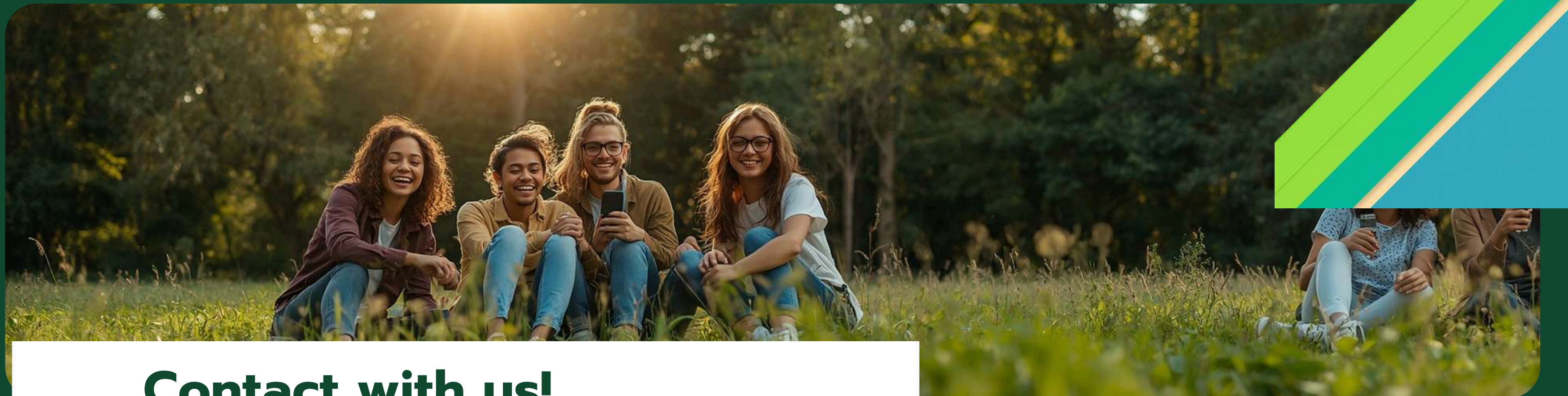
Explorer Pass 2026.
