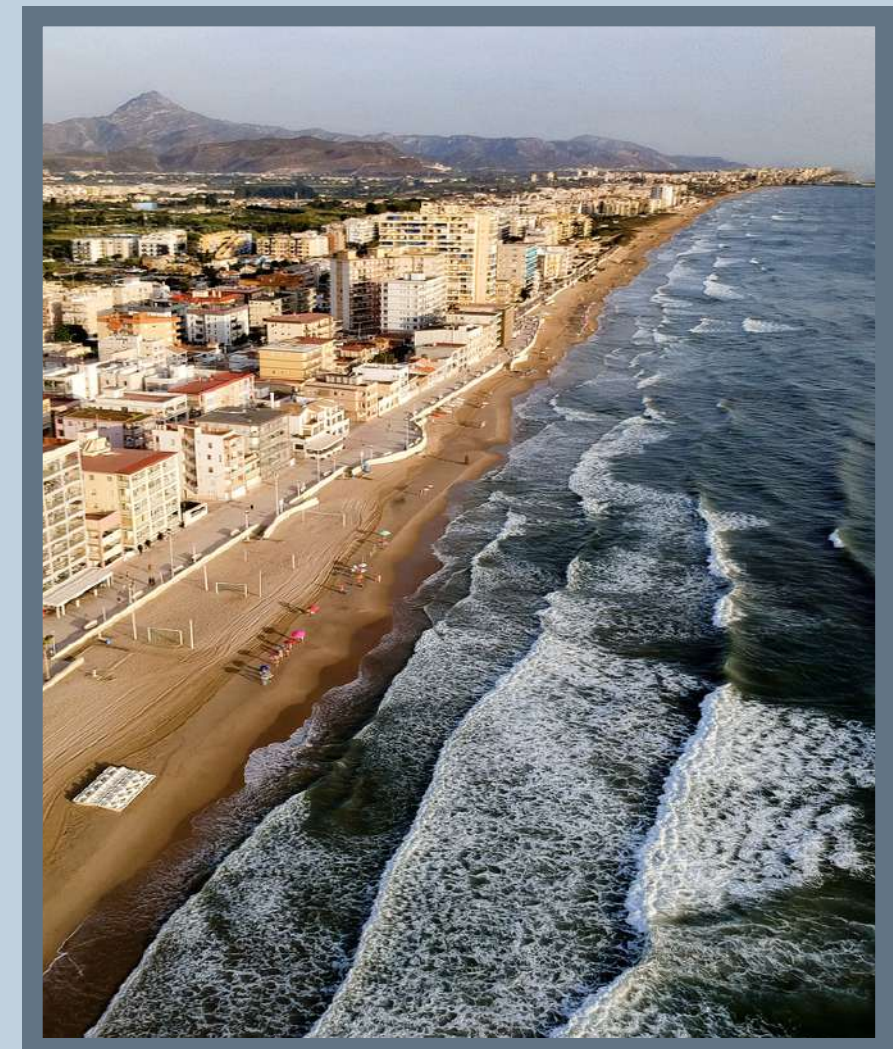

ABOUT THE EVENT

This 3-day Town Twinning gathering in Bellreguard and Vilallonga is designed to strengthen European civic ties by placing youth participation at the heart of local democracy. The event focuses on bringing together young people, youth workers, educators, and local decision-makers to exchange real-world practices on civic engagement, EU fundamental rights, and democratic decision-making.

Through interactive workshops, policy role-playing, and field visits to local municipal youth initiatives, participants will actively collaborate across borders. The main objective of this meeting is to co-create actionable youth proposals and draft a joint **Youth Manifesto for a Sustainable and Inclusive Europe**, empowering participants to take a leading role in shaping their communities.

A total of **60 participants** will take part in this international mobility:

- Spain (Host): Local youth, youth workers & local decision-makers from Bellreguard & Vilallonga.
- Poland: 12 participants (Gmina Dywity).
- Lithuania: 13 participants (Vilnius / Tavo Europa).

- Youth workers and educators
- Local political and institutional representatives

Day 2

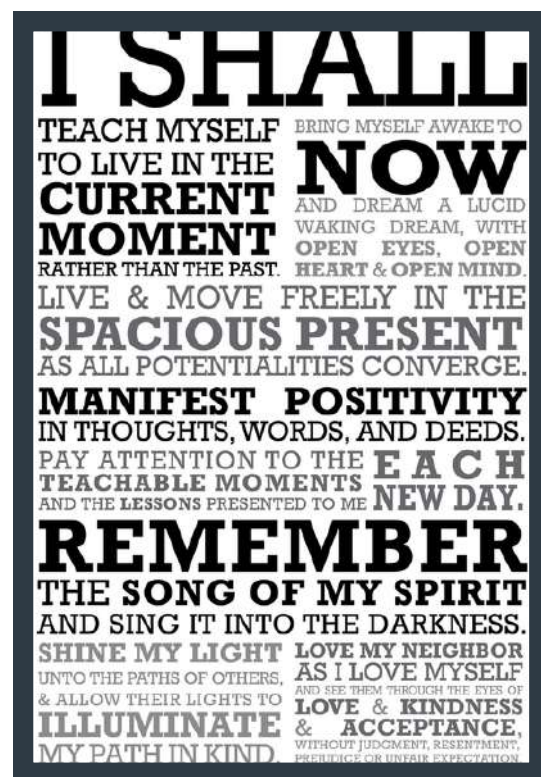
Co-Creation & Local Action
